

**Fire Medic – Lateral Transfer  
City of Bedford Fire Department**

The City of Bedford, Ohio is accepting applications from qualified candidates to establish a Lateral Transfer Certified list for the position of Fire Medic.

Minimum Requirements: Applicants must be a United States Citizen, must be 18 years of age; must possess valid State of Ohio Driver’s License.

An applicant must have worked as a Fire Medic within the past two (2) years and have at least one (1) year of full-time experience or 2,496 hours of part time work as a fire medic in any political subdivision in the State of Ohio as of the application deadline. The applicant must have a current State of Ohio Paramedic certification as well as Firefighter II certification. Candidates with the above qualification will be given a score of 70 points. Extra points for ranking purposes will be given for: Military service (2 pts.), a passing score taking the Cuyahoga Community College physical agility test within the past 3 years (4 pts.) with a time of 4:30 or less, Associates (2 pts.) and or Bachelor’s degree (4 pts.) and residency (2 pts.). A maximum of 10 extra credit points can be earned by an applicant. Applications and all documentation regarding points and identification must be presented to the Bedford Civil Service Commission by the deadline of September 1, 2023 at 4:00 p.m.

Qualified applicants will be subject to, but not limited to, fingerprinting, medical examination, polygraph testing, extensive background investigation, psychological examination, and personal interview.

\_\_\_\_\_ Bachelor Degree (4 points) or Associates Degree (2 point) transcript **or** certificate of degree at time of filing (capped at 4 points).

\_\_\_\_\_ Military Service (2 points) copy of DD214 form with honorable discharge & reentry eligibility code that reflects this status. The following US Army re-entry will not be acceptable for additional points; however, not limited to: RE-4R, most RE-3's and some RE-2's

\_\_\_\_\_ Residency (2 Point) Candidate living within the City of Bedford at least 6-months prior to the filing deadline of September 1, 2023.
