### **Chipper Service**

September 4 and October 2, 2023.

All items need to be on the curb and called live streamed via the City of Bedford's into the Service Department, 440-735-6583, YouTube Channel. before the start of brush pick up for that month. We will not add addresses once pick up Household Hazardous Waste Round-up has begun for that month.

Place branches on tree lawn with cut end facing the street. Branches cannot be larger than 10 inches in diameter. Leave limbs as long as possible for continuous feed into the chipper. Limbs exceeding 10 inches in diameter, or less than 3 feet in length will not be picked up.
