#### Friendly Reminder

Don't forget to turn your clocks back one hour As a reminder to all residents and property owners, no person shall purposely or knowingly feed, cause to be fed, or provide food for deer can access such food, or through groundfeeding stations, salt licks or other established mechanisms to feed deer on lands publicly or privately owned.

> No person shall purposely or knowingly feed, cause to be fed, or provide food for any undomesticated animals in any location.

> The City of Bedford, and/or the Division of Wildlife may initiate a civil action in the Court of Common Pleas for injunctive and other relief for any violation of this section.

> Whoever violates this section is guilty of a misdemeanor of the fourth degree for the first offense and misdemeanor of the first degree for each subsequent offense. A separate offense shall be deemed committed on each day on or during which a violation of this ordinance occurs (Bedford Codified Ordinance 8482-09).



#### **Bear Cub Basketball**


