



The recommended roadway widening along South Point Roa and RL Stowe/Nixon and South Point High School is expected to provide:

- Improvements in traffic operations (LOS)
- Decreases in travel delay times
- Reductions in vehicle queue length
- Potential safety, social and environmental benefits



The recommended roadway widening and turn lane improvements along South Point Road and Belmont Middle School are expected to provide:

- Significant LOS improvement: LOS F to LOS C in the AM peak hour.
- Significant queue reductions in the northbound direction, from 1200' in both AM and PM under No-Build conditions, to 333 feet in the AM and 217 feet in the PM under buildout conditions





The recommended signalization and turn lane improvement at South Point Road and Armstrong Road is expected to provide:

- A dedicated southbound right-turn lane on South Point Road
- Installation of a wood pole traffic signal
- Significant queue reduction on the eastbound approach of Armstrong Road: 2,600' during both the AM and PM peak hours under No-Build conditions, to 531' in the AM and 414' in the PM under the buildout conditions.
