Automated Collection

Belmont's new recycling and solid waste provider, Waste Pro, uses fully automated collection vehicles which operate a mechanical arm to lift the carts. (Increasing collection



efficiency and reducing recycling cost - saving the City valuable tax dollars)

Roll-Out Carts

The new 96-gallon roll-out carts hold more, have a lid to prevent littering, and are easier for residents to maneuver. New carts will be delivered to each resident at no cost. Do not begin using your new cart until July 5. (Due to the new

automated collection process, old bins can not be used beginning July 5. Keep your old bin or place it beside your recycle cart to be collected and recycled into new carts)


- Place carts with wheels facing your home.
- Keep carts 2 feet from one another and 2 feet from parked cars, mailboxes, etc.
- Do not block sidewalks with carts.

Every Other Week Collection

Collection of Yard Waste and Recycling will remain the same day as your garbage collection, but picked up every other week—saving tax dollars and reducing air pollution (you'll receive a schedule).

Yard Waste

Place loose Yard Waste in clear plastic bags. Maximum limb size: 6 feet in length and 12 inches in diameter.



Recycling

The new roll-out carts hold 5 times more than the old bins, enabling every other week collection.



Is it really trash?

Consider donating items that are in good condition or are repairable.

Garbage

Bag all garbage before placing in cart (this prevents litter). Only bags placed inside garbage cart will be picked up. Your garbage collection day will remain the same.



Bulky Items

Items too large to fit inside your garbage cart are bulky items (such as furniture, lawn mowers, etc.). Residents should call 704.792.0800 to schedule pickup of bulky items.

E-Waste

Any item with a circuit board is e-waste (such as TVs, computers, cell phones, etc.). Residents should call 704.792.0800 to schedule pickup of e-waste.
