

REQUEST FOR PREQUALIFICATIONS & OUTREACH MEETING NOTICE

Edifice is the Construction Manager for the City of Belmont Community Recreation Center. Edifice is currently seeking to prequalify contractors for subcontractor trade packages.

This project will be a 42,000 sf 2 story pre-engineered metal building and steel structure recreation center with 3 gyms, multipurpose and exercise studios, indoor play area, and offices for the City of Belmont, NC. The project is located at 1315 East Catawba Street in Belmont, NC. The owner is the City of Belmont. The designer is CPL Design Professionals.

Contractors are invited to pre-qualify for the following formal trade packages (but not limited to): concrete, masonry, steel, casework, roofing, waterproofing and sealants, metal panels, glass and glazing, drywall, flooring, painting, athletic flooring, gym equipment, pre-engineering metal building, skate park, plumbing, HVAC, electrical, low voltage, and sitework. These packages are a description of the work and not the final list of trade packages; the CM reserves the right to add or delete trade packages.

Informal Bid Packages:

Work that will not be part of the formal bid process and will not require submitting a prequalification statement (but not limited to): final cleaning, surveying, spray material fireproofing, doors/frames/hardware, overhead doors, acoustical ceilings and panels, tile, floor coatings, specialties, signage, operable partition, indoor play unit, dasher boards, appliances, window treatments, fireplace, elevator, dumb waiter, fire suppression, landscaping, and fencing. These packages are a description of the work and not the final list of trade packages; the CM reserves the right to add or delete trade packages.

All Prequalified bidders are required to seek HUB/Minority Business participation. Firms are encouraged to consider any and all possibilities for participation.

Bidders must be properly licensed under all state laws, regulations, and ordinances governing the respective trades and work to be performed. The General Statutes of the State of North Carolina applicable to license requirements, submission of bids, and award of public contracts shall be observed in the receiving of bids and awarding of contracts for the work.

Further information **may be** required in addition to this pre-qualification statement based on your response. These items may include additional financial statements, proof of applicable licenses, certification status, safety program/policy, drug and alcohol program/policy, additional project experience, and or certificates of insurance. Completing this statement does not guarantee prequalification.
