 - Shares to other local/neighborhood Facebook groups




SURVEY HIGHLIGHTS

- Out of the respondents, 70% of open space users utilize Belmont parks/ greenways and 40% utilize neighborhood parks/open spaces
- 95% of all respondents utilize public open space in general
- The most used public open spaces were
 - Parks & Playgrounds
 - Greenways or Walkways
 - River views/access
- Respondents wished Belmont had more of the following open spaces:
 - Greenways or Walkways
 - River views/access
 - Dog Park
 - Usable rooftop area
 - Open grassy area
 - Parks/Playgrounds
 - o Public Art
 - Community Garden




Do you have parks/open space in your current residential neighborhood?




Is this park/open space publicly maintained by the city of Belmont or privately maintained by the HOA?




If you answered yes, what type of open space does your neighborhood have? Select all that apply.



What type of open space do you wish your neighborhood had? Select all that apply.




Did access to parks/open space have an impact on why you chose your current residence location?





Do you utilize public parks/open space within Belmont as a whole?




What type of parks/open space do you utilize in Belmont? Select all that apply.



What type of open space do you wish Belmont, as a city, had more of and/or had at all? Select all that apply.




On average, how long does it take you to get to your most utilized open space area via car?


On average, how long does it take you to get to your most utilized open space area via walking?

Where is the open space you visit most frequently? Select all that apply.





Where are some of the places you visit most frequently?




How old are you?


How many people are in your household?





MEETINGS

- Developers/Builders/Realtors
 - Two meetings due to technical difficulties (Nov 17th and Nov 22nd)
 - Attendance: 5 developers/realtors
- HOA Managers/Presidents/Board Members
 - Meeting on November 18th
 - Attendance: 3 managers
- Municipal Planning and Parks & Rec Staff
 - o Meeting on November 18th
 - Attendance: 2 (from Gaston County and Matthews)



STAKEHOLDER MEETING HIGHTLIGHTS: DEVELOPERS/REALTORS

- Emphasized the cost and value of open space. Open space should be valuable and not something to build just to comply with city regs.
- Flexibility in both hardscape and natural space
- Well designed open space = a balance of purpose and quality
- Would like a payment-in-lieu option by right (to remove the political aspect)
 - o All in-lieu fees must be used within the area of the project
- Equitable to everyone experienced and inexperienced developers
- Trade off higher density allows for more money for open space
- Point System Option*

STAKEHOLDER MEETING HIGHTLIGHTS: HOA MANAGERS/PRESIDENTS

- Currently, most open space within communities are private
- © Certain people are willing to pay dues for amenities based on what residents value (pool, walking trails, etc.)
- Should add value to the community based on the purpose
- Financial hardships of open space based on type
- Dog parks popular and low cost/maintenance
- Often open space is over designed community programming and how open space will be used will come organically based on the residents/nature of the community

STAKEHOLDER MEETING HIGHTLIGHTS: MUNICIPAL STAFF

- A new trend is to maintain a natural buffer / a natural buffer along the road frontage
- Payment-in-lieu
 - Heavily utilized (in Matthews)
 - Based on nearby parks (Gaston County)

 - Preserve a balance between responsible development and open space in the context of economic development
