

Martha Property Acquisition Timeline – Key Milestones

Trust for Public Land & Martha Co. enter twoyear option at \$42.1M

TPL enters into separate agreement with MCOSD to transfer property to public ownership, if acquired.

Measure M passes with nearly 80% support

By January 2023, TPL and TOS have raised over 60% of funds. By February 2024, they have raised over 80%.

Marin County Board of Supervisors meeting on May 7 to review Martha


To sell bonds, MCOSD must see evidence of "full funding" raised or pledged.

Last day for TPL to exercise purchase option is June 14

TPL will have 60 to 90-days from exercise date to close escrow. Last COE date is September 13.
