RESOLUTION NO. 2024-11

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELVEDERE,
RECITING THE FACTS OF THE PRESIDENTIAL PRIMARY ELECTION HELD ON
MARCH 5, 2024, AND DECLARING THE RESULT OF MEASURE C**

WHEREAS, a Presidential Primary Election was held and conducted in the City of Belvedere, California, on Tuesday, March 5, 2024, as required by law and a local measure, Measure C, was submitted to the voters of Belvedere; and

WHEREAS, that in all respects the election was held and conducted and the votes were cast, received and canvassed and the returns made and declared in time, form and manner as required by the provisions of the Elections Code of the State of California for the holding of consolidated elections in general law cities; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolutions Nos. 2023-45 and 2023-46, adopted November 13, 2023, the City Council submitted Measure C, the Fire and Emergency Medical Services Appropriations Limit Adjustment, to the voters of Belvedere, and Measure C required majority vote approval to be adopted; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution Nos. 2023-45 and 2023-46, the County Registrar of Voters canvassed the returns of the March 5, 2024 election and has certified the results to this City Council, the results are received, attached, and made a part hereof as Exhibit "A."

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Belvedere as follows:

SECTION 1. That the whole number of ballots cast in the City was 893.

SECTION 2. That the following measure was voted upon: Measure C, City of Belvedere, Fire and Emergency Medical Services Appropriations Limit Adjustment.

SECTION 3. The City Council does declare and determine that: (a) of the 870 votes cast regarding Measure C, 679 (78.05%) voted in favor of the measure; and (b) Measure C passed and is adopted.

SECTION 4. The City Clerk shall enter on the records of the City Council of the City a statement of the result of the election, showing: (a) the whole number of votes cast in the City; (b) the measure voted upon; and (c) the number of votes given in the City's single precinct for and against the measure.

SECTION 5. That the City Clerk shall certify the passage and adoption of this resolution and enter it into the book of original resolutions.

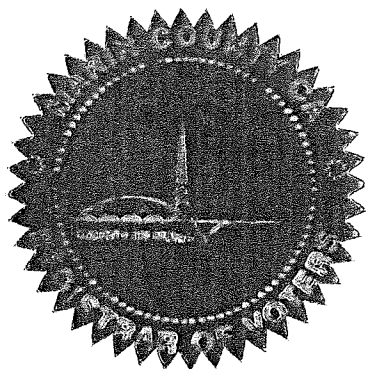
