RESOLUTION NO. 2024-12

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELVEDERE
APPROPRIATING ROAD REPAIR AND ACCOUNTABILITY ACT FUNDING AND
INCLUDING IN THE FY2024-2025 BUDGET A LIST OF PROJECTS FUNDED BY SB 1: THE
ROAD REPAIR AND ACCOUNTABILITY ACT**

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 1 (SB 1), the Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017 (Chapter 5, Statutes of 2017) was passed by the Legislature and Signed into law by the Governor in April 2017 to address the significant multi-modal transportation funding shortfalls statewide; and

WHEREAS, SB 1 includes accountability and transparency provisions that will ensure the residents of our City are aware of the projects proposed for funding in our community and which projects have been completed each fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, the City must adopt by resolution a list of projects proposed to receive fiscal year funding from the Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account (RMRA), created by SB 1, which must include a description and the location of each proposed project, a proposed schedule for the project's completion, and the estimated useful life of the improvement; and

WHEREAS, the City, will receive an estimated \$54,333 in RMRA funding in Fiscal Year 2024-25 from SB 1; and

WHEREAS, this is the eighth year in which the City is receiving SB 1 funding and will enable the City to continue essential road maintenance and rehabilitation projects, safety improvements and increasing access and mobility options for the traveling public that would not have otherwise been possible without SB 1; and

WHEREAS, the City used a Pavement Management System to develop the SB 1 project list to ensure revenues are being used on the most high-priority and cost-effective projects that also meet the community's priorities for transportation investment; and

WHEREAS, the funding from SB 1 will help the City maintain and rehabilitate seven streets/roads throughout the City this year and many similar projects into the future; and

WHEREAS, the 2021 California Statewide Local Streets and Roads Needs Assessment found that the City's streets and roads are in a "very good" condition and this revenue will help increase the overall quality of the City's road system and over the next decade will maintain streets and roads in a "very good" condition; and

WHEREAS, the SB 1 project list and overall investment in our local streets and roads infrastructure with a focus on basic maintenance and safety, investing in complete streets

infrastructure, and using cutting-edge technology, materials and practices, will have significant positive co-benefits statewide.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Belvedere, as follows:

1. The foregoing recitals are true and correct.
2. The following list of proposed road work project locations will be funded in part or solely with the fiscal year 2024-25 Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account revenues:

Eucalyptus Road from Golden Gate Road to End; Lagoon Road from San Rafael Ave to Cove Road; West Shore Road from San Rafael Ave to End; Alcatraz Road from 1 Alcatraz to Bellevue Avenue; Peninsula Road from Beach Road to End, and Beach Road from San Rafael Ave. to Belvedere Ave. The work will consist of crack sealing, selective patch repairs and sections of paving grind and overlay, which will add 5-7 years to the lifespans of these roadways. This work is expected to begin in the Summer of 2024.


3. The following previously proposed and adopted projects may utilize fiscal year 2024-25 and previous Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account revenues in their delivery. With the relisting of these projects in the adopted fiscal year resolution, the City is reaffirming to the public and the State our intent to fund these projects with Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account revenues:
 - Pine Avenue (Golden Gate Road to Belvedere Avenue), originally listed in FY 2022-23: Pine Avenue was removed from the slurry sealing project in 2023 to reduce the disruption to traffic flow during the project. It is anticipated that it will be included in a slurry seal project proposed for 2025 and will add 5-7 years to the lifespan of this roadway.
 - Tamalpais Avenue (Golden Gate to Golden Gate Avenue), originally listed in FY 2022-23: Tamalpais Avenue was removed from the slurry sealing project in 2023 to reduce the parking and traffic disruption to residents caused by the slurry work on the adjoining North Point Circle. It is anticipated that it will be included in a slurry seal project proposed for 2025 and will add an estimated 5-7 years to the lifespan of this roadway.
 - Community Road (Leeward Rd. to San Rafael Ave) originally listed in FY 2019/20: Road work on Community Road is being delayed until after the anticipated impacts of Mallard Pointe development which is expected to be completed in FY2029/30. This project is estimated to begin in FY2030/31. This schedule is expected to change as it is part of a larger project. The scope of work will include all aspects of rehabilitation as needed to add an estimated 15 years to the lifespan of this roadway.
