He presented the location where the bench would be placed and the reasoning behind the placement. Resident Bryan Kemnitzer spoke about the doner plaque and his research on options. 3. Report from Public Works Director, Antony Boyd

Director Boyd welcomed attendees to the first meeting of 2023 and reminded all to keep their microphones on mute unless speaking. He then reported that Public Works crews have aerated and overseeded in parks and the Community Park playground inspection was done and passed. There were extra chips installed. Tree work has been done in the form of four Monterey pines removed on Golden Gate and Lagoon Roads. Tree work was done at Centennial Park and soil testing was performed around the historic pear tree in Community Park. Soil results are pending for spring fertilizing. Pines were trimmed on San Rafael Avenue. Debris removal was done in several lane locations. Looking ahead, will be lots of additional maintenance work needed in parks and turf areas.
