If the developers for the proposed Mallard Pointe project are given the green light to build a 23-unit apartment building in the R-2 zone, no Belvedere homeowner is safe from a similarly massive structure sprouting up next door.

Why has no one ever asked to erect an apartment building in R-2 before? And why has no one requested to build one in the R-15 zone or one of the R-1 zones in the city – all of which, like R-2 prohibit apartment buildings? The answer is simple: Most people feel obligated to follow the rules that clearly state apartment buildings and apartment courts are only allowed in areas zoned R-3 or R-3C.
