## **BELVEDERE-TIBURON JOINT RECREATION COMMITTEE**

The governing Committee consists of nine members: three appointed by the City of Belvedere, three appointed by the Town of Tiburon, a Council Member from each municipality, and a ninth member designated "at-large" and appointed to the extent possible by the Reed Union School District.

In June 1975 the City of Belvedere and Town of Tiburon entered into a Joint Powers Agreement that established the Belvedere-Tiburon Joint Recreation Committee, known today as The Ranch Board of Directors. The purpose of the agreement was to create a recreation committee that would formulate, administer, and operate recreation programs and facilities for the residents of Belvedere and Tiburon.
