

Over 2 inches of rain are expected to fall in our area within 24 hours. Rain and winds could be heavy at times. For current emergency conditions and information in Marin County, including Belvedere and Tiburon, go to <https://emergency.marincounty.org>. Get Ready for the rainy winter conditions that can cause flooding, landslides, and power outages. Here are some ways to get prepared:

Communications

- Local emergency information, including weather, power outages, and road closures can be found at <https://emergency.marincounty.org>
- Make sure you are signed up for emergency alerts at www.alertmarin.org. Winter tips and local information can be heard on SNAP radio 840am.
- Complete weather information including weather alerts can be found at www.weather.gov.

Sandbags

- If you are in an area prone to or likely to flood, have sandbags in place prior to the rainstorms.
- Sandbags are available to residents in three locations:
 1. Community Road. – corner of Community Rd. & Mallard Rd.
 2. West Shore Road. – opposite #71 West Shore Rd.
 3. Lagoon Road. – opposite #50 Lagoon Rd.
- Sand, bags and shovels are available but be prepared to fill the bags yourself.

Power Outages

- In the event of a power outage, information on the outage can be obtained at (800) 743-5000 or at www.pge.com.
- Be prepared for outages by having battery operated lanterns, lamps or lights ready and easily accessible and keep your devices charged.

Wind

- Heavy winds can lead to damage caused by heavy items being blown about, fallen trees and downed power lines.
- Please secure all patio furniture, boats, and other items to protect your home.
- In the event of a fallen tree or downed power line, stay clear of the area and call the police department at (415) 435-3266 and they will notify the appropriate response personnel.

Landslides

- Inspect your property for land movement, retaining wall failure or drainage ditch and downspouts issues.
- Clean out ditches, drains and gutters for proper water to flow away from your structure.
- Know multiple escape routes from your home and yard and evacuate from your property if you discover earth movement or landslide.

Driver Safety

- When driving in the rain use extra caution and always have your headlights on.
- Remember, if you turn on your windshield wipers, turn on your headlights.
- Please obey the speed limits and follow other traffic at a safe distance.
