A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELVEDERE MODIFYING THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PLAN FOR FISCAL YEAR 2023-2024 AND REALLOCATING PROJECT FUNDS TO ADDRESS POLICE STAFFING SHORTAGE

WHEREAS, the Belvedere Police Department plays a vital role in ensuring the safety of its residents by maintaining law and order and curtailing criminal activities; and

WHEREAS, the recent loss of personnel necessitates hiring an additional officer to maintain current service levels and prevent attrition of existing staff; and

WHEREAS, hiring an additional officer is not a commitment to lift the 7th officer position deferral, and additional analysis by the Finance Committee and City Council may be needed to reprioritize capital projects and city services in the coming 2024-2025 fiscal year budget planning process; and

WHEREAS, the Modifications to the Capital Improvement Plan and Budget Amendment herein are not a "project" under the California Environmental Quality Act;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Belvedere that the following modifications to the Belvedere Capital Improvement Plan and Fiscal Year 2023-24 budget are hereby ratified.

Transfer a total of \$138,187 from the following capital projects to Department 30, Police Salaries & Benefits:

- FY 2022/23 Corp Yard Solar Electric & EV Charging Stations, \$103,187
- FY 2023/24 Painting of the Corp Yard \$10,000
- FY 2023/24 City Hall Renovations \$25,000
