RESOLUTION NO. 2023-50

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELVEDERE DECLARING CERTAIN CITY VEHICLE TO BE SURPLUS PROPERTY AND AUTHORIZING THE POLICE CHIEF TO DISPOSE OF VEHICLE BY AUCTION

WHEREAS, State law permits cities to dispose of personal property in any manner so long as the disposal is for the common public benefit (Cal. Const. art. XI, § 5; Gov. Code, §§ 37350-37351); and

WHEREAS, the City no longer has use for a 2014 Dodge Charger, Vehicle Identification Number 2C3CDXAT7EH357928 (the "Vehicle"); and

WHEREAS, the Vehicle is no longer necessary for City use because it has outlived its useful life and requires additional upkeep and repairs; and

WHEREAS, based on the above, the City finds that it is for the common public benefit to declare the Vehicle as surplus property and authorize the Police Chief to dispose of the Vehicle by auction; and

WHEREAS, the disposition of the vehicle is not subject to the California Environmental Quality Act ("CEQA") because it is not a project under CEQA. (14 Cal. Code Regs., § 15378); and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Belvedere that:

1. The Vehicle is surplus to the needs of the City and disposing of the Vehicle is for the common public benefit; and
2. The Police Chief shall dispose of the Vehicle by auction.


