

**BOROUGH OF MOUNT POCONO
ORDINANCE NO. 2 OF 2020**

**AN ORDINANCE REDUCING THE SEATS ON THE PLANNING COMMISSION
FROM SEVEN TO FIVE**

WHEREAS, the Pennsylvania Municipalities Planning Code provides that a Planning Commission may have a maximum of nine and a minimum of three members; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Mount Pocono Planning Commission presently consists of seven members as is established by previous Ordinances of the Borough; and

WHEREAS, Borough Council has determined that it is in the best interest of the Borough to reduce the number of seats on the planning commission from seven to five; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission has formerly requested Borough Council to consider reduction of the number of seats on the Planning Commission from seven to five;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ENACTED and ORDAINED as follows:


1. The Mount Pocono Planning Commission shall as of the effective date of this Ordinance consist of five members appointed by the Mount Pocono Borough Council in accordance with the provisions of the Pennsylvania Municipalities Planning Code.
2. This Ordinance shall repeal any inconsistent Ordinances.
3. This Ordinance shall be effective immediately.


