## **RESOLUTION NO. 10 OF 2020**

## BOROUGH OF MOUNT POCONO MONROE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

A Resolution of Borough of Mount Pocono Pertaining to Service Hours Purchased by the Borough of Mount Pocono in the Year 2020 from the Pocono Mountain Regional Police

WHEREAS, the Borough of Mount Pocono is a party municipality to an Intergovernmental Agreement as amended, creating the Pocono Mountain Regional Police Department; and

WHEREAS, coverage issues pertaining to calendar year 2020 need to be addressed by Resolution pertaining to service hours purchased by the Borough of Mount Pocono;

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOVLED AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The Borough's commitment to PPUs for the 2020 fiscal year has been resolved by participating municipality Tobyhanna Township, agreeing to pick up the budgeted difference from Mount Pocono Borough;
- 2. Mount Pocono will drop .24% of coverage, roughly 3.5 hours per week.
- 3. Tobyhanna Township will pick up Mount Pocono's .24% coverage drop, roughly 3.5 hours per week.
- 4. As a result of the above, PMRPC will reduce Mount Pocono Borough's contribution by \$14,548.41.
- 5. Mount Pocono will owe the difference in the amount of \$98.29 between the 2019 and 2020 PPU rate.
