A RESOLUTION OF MOUNT POCONO BOROUGH, COUNTY OF MONROE ESTABLISHING A SAFETY COMMISSION

Be it RESOLVED, that the Borough of Mount Pocono of Monroe County establishes a Safety Commission comprising of Borough residents, tax payers, and business owners. The Safety Commission will comprise of five (5) members requiring a Chair, Vice Chair and three (3) voting members with a non-voting liaison representing Borough Council. The members of the Safety Commission will be appointed by Borough Council with three (3) two-year terms and two (2) three-year terms.

Be it FURTHER RESOLVED, that Safety Commission consist with the following powers and duties:

- Identify Public Safety Concerns
- Identify Traffic Safety Concerns
- Identify Pedestrian Safety Concerns
- Assist developing and revising Safety Policy and Procedures
- Provide solutions and recommendations to address the above issues
- Seek out and apply for grants for the above issues
- Maintain records regarding the status and condition of Safety measures
- Provide monthly reports to Borough Council at a public meeting including recommendations to address issues and/or identify needs for financial support
- All financial obligations must be approved by Borough Council prior to any actions taken
