surface which is more than 30 inches above the floor or grade below shall have guards.
No unfilled openings in circuit breaker box.
Current certification of sprinkler system by licensed sprinkler company.
Fire alarm and monitoring systems tested and functioning.
All buildings with kitchen ventilation hoods/ansul system must have system certified by licensed
installer.
Means of egress clearly marked and unobstructed with exit signs and emergency lighting.
