

Safety Commission Minutes

Date: Monday, September, 25, 2023

Place: The Borough Building

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm.

In Attendance: Master Kim, C. Farrugia, D. Fulton and L. Noonan. J. Bohdal was absent. A quorum was present.

Approval of Minutes

D. Fulton moved to accept the meeting minutes of May 22, 2023, as presented. C. Farrugia seconded. Motion carried.

Officer's Report

Chair:

Master Kim discussed the following items:

Master Kim said that the 6th amended installation plan for Radar Signs and RRFBS was submitted to Penn DOT by the Barry Isett Association. Master Kim contacted the Borough Traffic Engineer, and he was awaiting the permit/approval.

New Business

The Two Potholes at the Five Points Intersection

Master Kim said Penn DOT fixed the two potholes at the Five Points Intersection.

Pocono Blvd. Gateway Sketch

Debra Fulton said that the Borough Council postponed the proposed Gateway Sketch. They wanted to see how the Radar Signs and RRFBS would work after installing them (RRFBS and Radar Signs).

Railroad Trestle Sign Replacement

Christine Farrugia reported contacting the railroad administrator. She was directed to email her a Safety Commission-approved image of what would go on the railroad banner and pictures of both sides of what is there now.

Fork Street Easement for RRFB

Master Kim discussed the easement agreement with Christine, the owner of the Fork Street parking lot, about installing an RRFB on her property. She and Debra wanted to meet in the parking lot later to decide on the easement.

Temporary Meeting for Fork Street RRFB (October 2, 2023, at 6 pm)

Master Kim said the Borough engineer suggested relocating the Fork Street RRFB site to the parking lot adjacent to the crosswalk because Penn DOT didn't allow installing the light on the sidewalk. Debra Fulton and Christine Farrugia disagreed with the relocation because they thought the suggested spot didn't make sense; Jodi Bohdal suggested asking the engineer if we could install the light on the position where the Crosswalk sign was standing. Master Kim said he would contact the engineer to ask for the suggested spot.
