#### Survivor Housing: Commercial Mobile Home Parks

Survivor families are finding temporary housing at 19 commercial parks throughout Northern California, where FEMA is currently leasing a total of 358 pads. As of September 5th, 223 survivor households are housed in these commercial parks.

#### **Housing Success:**

With all four FEMA temporary housing communities completed in Butte County, survivor households are quickly moving in and all survivors have moved out of the transitional sheltering program (TSA). The TSA program has ended and there are no households currently waiting for housing.

#### **TOWN OF PARADISE**

Over <u>100</u> building permit applications are in "plan check" with the Town of Paradise, and <u>186</u> permits have been issued. Expectations are optimistic that <u>500</u> permits will be issued by the end of the year.

Total enrollment for Paradise Unified School District (PUSD) is <u>1742</u> students (51% of pre-fire enrollment). Disaster experts predicted only 33% enrollment this year, so to have over 50% is a huge accomplishment and a testament to the commitment of staff and the community.
