Some Good News

The Town of Paradise received its **1,000**th **building permit application** after the Camp Fire on Wednesday, May 27th! The first building permit was issued on March 28th, 2019 to the Buzzard family. The rate of building permits has far exceeded expectations and the momentum is full speed ahead.

- Rebuild Paradise Foundation awards nearly \$52,000 to Camp Fire builds. These funds are part of the Missing Middle grant program and are used to reimburse qualified applicants for part of their pre-construction costs and help incentivize their return home.
