



## Town of Paradise - Camp Fire Recovery Mandatory Hazard Tree Removal - Private Tree Program Arborist's/Forester's Certification Form

*This form is to be completed by an ISA Certified Arborist (with Tree Risk Assessment Qualification-TRAQ) or a Registered Professional Forester (qualified pursuant to California Public Resources Code section 752).*

Town of Paradise Ordinance 595 defines a Hazard Tree as a wildfire-damaged tree that in the professional opinion of an Arborist and/or Forester: (A) has been so severely damaged by the Camp Fire that its structural integrity is compromised; and (B) poses an imminent danger of falling within five (5) years, onto a public right-of-way, other public improved property, or eligible private road.
