

Butte County - North Complex Mandatory Hazard Tree Removal – Private Tree Program Arborist's/Forester's Certification Form

This form is to be completed by an ISA Certified Arborist (with Tree Risk Assessment Qualification -TRAQ) or Registered Professional Forester (qualified pursuant to California Public Resources Code section 752).

Section 54-10 of the Butte County Code defines a Hazard Tree as a wildfire-damaged tree that in the professional opinion of an Arborist and/or Forester: (A) has been so severely damaged by the North Complex Fire that its structural integrity is compromised; and (B) poses an imminent danger of falling onto a public road or right–of-way, other public improved property, or eligible private road.
