The Agri-tourism and Industries (AGI) zone represents a zone that provides for commercial and in some cases light industrial uses that have evolved from agricultural activities typical to the Snoqualmie Valley. Uses include marketing, processing and assembling agricultural, dairy, bakery, landscape, nursery and garden accessories; marketing, processing and assembling prepared foods and drinks for consuming on site or for distribution; and marketing of entertainment activities including festivals and educational experiences. Tourist related activities may include restaurants, retail stores, overnight accommodation, petting zoos, performances, amusement parks and similar activities. (Ord. 700 § 6 (Exh.
