I am pleased to inform you that King County's Department of Human Services' (DCHS) Housing, Homelessness, and Community Development Division (HHCDD) has approved a \$374,519 conditional award for City of Carnation's McKinley Avenue Sidewalk Improvements. Congratulations!

Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funding will be dedicated to curb, gutter, sidewalk, stormwater, and ADA curb ramp improvements. The proposed improvements will provide a safe pedestrian facility and to allow for safe accessibility for the elderly and disabled. Funding awards are subject to funding availability.
