

By agreeing to the Terms and Conditions of the Permitting Portal, I declare as follows:

I am hereby making application for a permit in accordance with the description I provide.

Public Disclosure Notice:

All records, including but not limited to documents, maps, plans, photographs, financial and proprietary information, or other material, regardless of physical form, characteristics, or means of transmission, submitted will become the property of the City. All records will become a matter of public record by virtue of their submission to the City, a public entity, and will be subject to disclosure under the Washington Public Records Act without prior notice to the submitter. The City will not in any way be liable or responsible for any claims, actions, damages, and expenses (including but not limited to court costs and reasonable attorney's fees), resulting from, arising out of, or in any way connected with the disclosure of any such records or portions thereof if the disclosure is made pursuant to a public records request.

1. I understand that the submittal fee and plan review fee is non-refundable once the review process has begun, whether or not I choose to withdraw my application.
2. I agree to comply with all applicable City ordinances and standards of development.
3. The granting of this permit does not give authority to violate or cancel the provisions of any state or local law regulating construction.
4. I understand and agree that the construction for which this permit is required shall be subject to inspection by the building official or his designee and such construction shall remain accessible and exposed for inspection purposes until approved and I authorize employees/agents of the City of Carnation to enter onto the property which is the subject of this application during regular business hours. The sole purpose of entry is to make any examination of the property which is necessary to process this application.
5. I agree to display the issued permit, inspection card and applicable approved plans onsite at all times.
6. I agree to abide by the City of Carnation's construction hours: Monday-Friday 7:00 am-7:00 pm. Saturday, Sunday and Legal Holidays: 9:00 am-6:00 pm.
7. As the project applicant / property owner, I understand it is my responsibility to assure that no soils, wash water, or waste products from my project enter the storm drain, are washed into the road, or are allowed to enter any water body. It is my responsibility to assure that my contractors are aware of these requirements.



8. I declare that:

- A. I am a contractor currently registered and properly licensed in accordance with chapter RCW 18.27; or
- B. I am the owner or authorized agent of the property for which I am applying for permit and acknowledge that I am not a licensed contractor, specialty or general; or
- C. I am otherwise exempt from the requirements set forth in RCW 18.27.090 and will abide by all provisions and conditions of the exemption as stated. I agree that if I use any person(s) to provide labor and/or assistance, I will retain only contractors registered and currently licensed as required under the laws of the State of Washington. I certify under penalty of perjury that the above is true and correct.
