Expanded Passport Hours

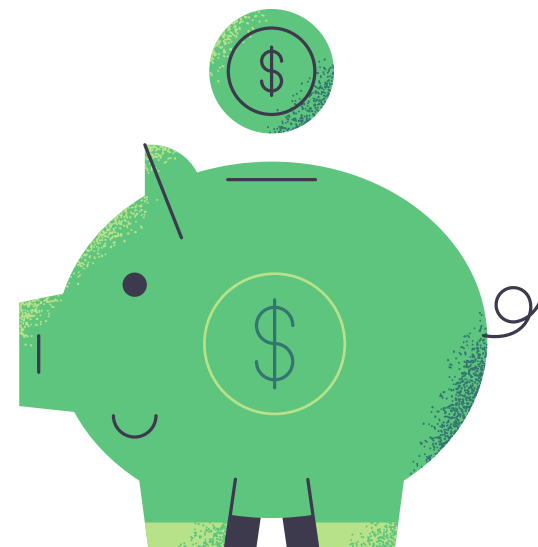
- Results: Record of 32 per day processed and 70 per week

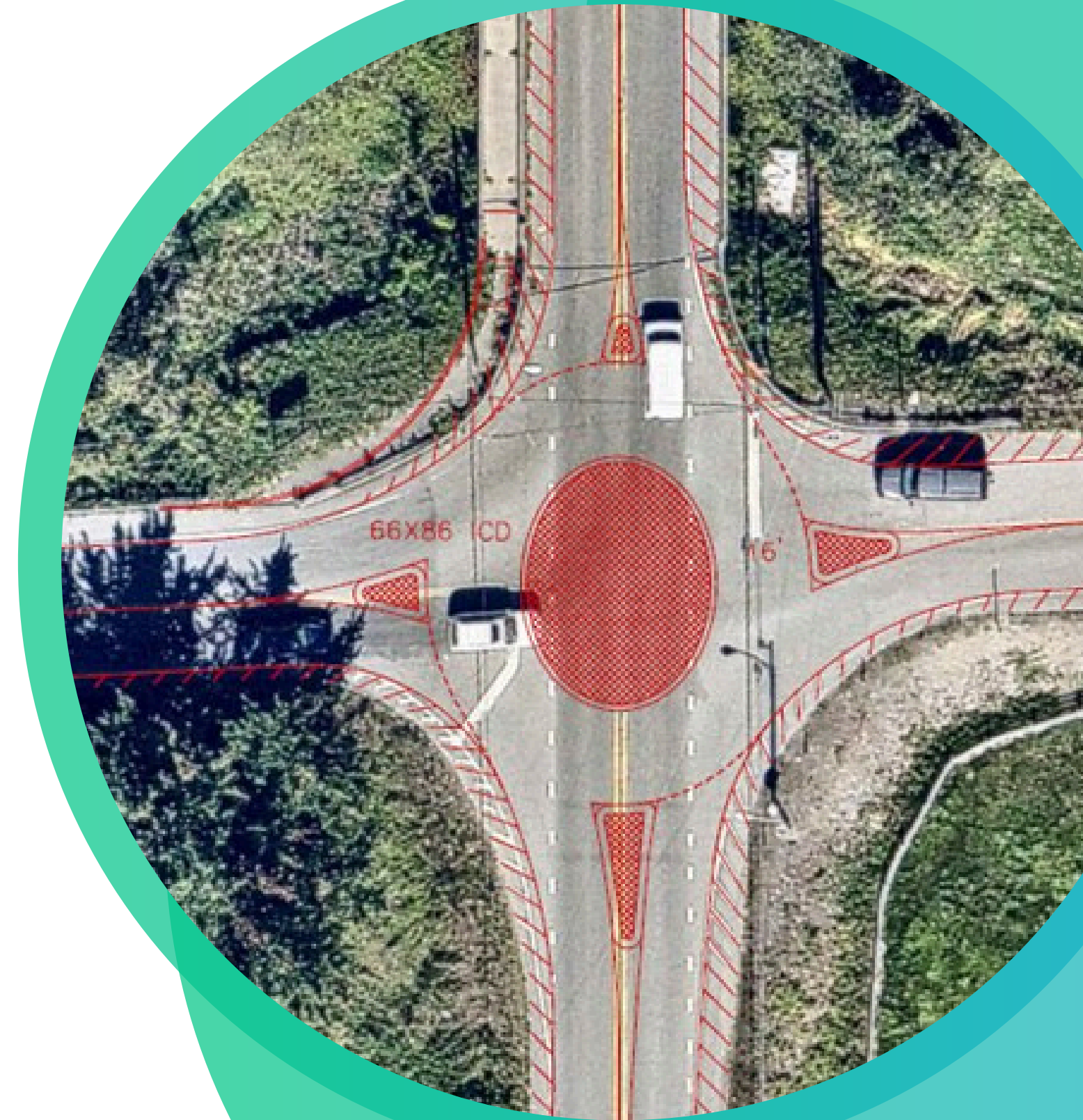
