Other applicable regulations pertaining to signs may include the requirement of a Building Permit and Business License.

Signs for houses of worship, institutional, governmental and school identification
<ul> <li>(CMC 15.68.090):</li> <li>☐ Identification: may have one of the following:</li> <li>☐ Freestanding: may not exceed 6' feet in height and must be located a minimum of 5' from a public street r-o-w or rear yard. Must have one square foot of landscaping around the base per square foot of sign face. OR</li> <li>☐ Wall mounted: May not exceed 32 square feet in size.</li> <li>☐ One additional mural, symbol, emblem or mascot, including words and/or graphics.</li> </ul>
Signs for non-residential uses in the RA zone (15.68.100): Such signs must not exceed 24 square feet in area, may not be internally lit and may be either:
<ul><li>☐ Freestanding: shall not exceed 6' in height, one per use of building site, must have 20 square feet of landscaping, OR</li><li>☐ Wall mounted.</li></ul>
Signs in the CBD, SC and LI/M zones and businesses in the MU zone with frontage on Tolt Avenue (CMC 15.68.110)  Portable signs: such signs do not require a permit.  Fuel Price: one sign per street frontage, may be freestanding or attached to canopy columns, and may include changeable copy. Fuel pump informational signs must not
exceed 2 square feet.  Window signs: maximum of 50% of the total window area. May be constructed of neon, stained glass, etched glass, gold leaf or cut vinyl. May be internally lit if neon or stained glass. Painted over windows will be subject to the regulations regarding blank walls (See Design Standards section 1.1.2)
Projecting signs: Shall not extend above the building parapet, soffit eave line or roof of the building, shall not project more than 6' from the building face and must be a minimum of 8" above the sidewalk. One such sign is permitted per business or other non-residential use.
Freestanding signs: may be monument or standing signs. Monument signs are only allowed where the building is setback at minimum of 20' from the r-o-w. Freestanding sings for developments up to 25,000 square feet may be no more than 42" in height and a maximum of 20 square feet in size. All freestanding signs require one square foot of landscaping around the base for every square foot of sign face, and must be set back at least 5' from any r-o-w.
Wall signs: Such signs shall not exceed 10% of the façade area and may be permitted on a maximum of two facades. Wall signs may not extend above the building parapet, soffit, eave line or roof, and must be mounted plumb with the underlying building unless the sign incorporates sculptural or architectural elements. Sign frames must be concealed



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or integrated into the building's architectural character.  Marquee signs: Shall not exceed 65% of the vertical face of the marquee, canopy or awning, and may not be placed on the sloping portion of a canopy or awning. The height of the vertical face of a marquee, canopy or awning shall not exceed one foot. The marquee, canopy or awning must be at least 8' above the sidewalk or walkway.  Under Marquee sign: Such signs shall not exceed 2' in height, and must have 1' minimum between the sign and the outer edge of the marquee, awning, or canopy, and between the sign and building façade. Such signs shall maintain a minimum clearance of 8' between the sidewalk and the bottom of the sign.
