

The Board of Trustees of the *Charter Township of Kalamazoo* held a Work Session Meeting on **Monday, January 8, 2018** at **5:30 p.m.** in the Board Room of the Charter Township of Kalamazoo Administration Building, 1720 Riverview Drive, Kalamazoo, Michigan 49004-1099, for the purpose of discussing Work Session Meeting Agenda items, and any other business that may legally come before the Board of Trustees of the Charter Township of Kalamazoo, Kalamazoo County.

PRESENT: Supervisor Donald Martin, Clerk Mark Miller, Treasurer Sherine Miller, Trustees Jeremy Hathcock, Nicolette Leigh, Steven Leuty and Jennifer Strebs.

ABSENT: None

ALSO PRESENT: Township Manager Dexter Mitchell, Fire Chief David Obreiter, and Township Attorney Roxanne Seeber.

Supervisor Martin called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m.

Item 1 – MANAGER REVIEW DISCUSSION (CLOSED SESSION)

Trustee Hathcock moved, seconded by Treasurer Miller, the Township Board go into closed session pursuant to the Open Meetings Act, MCL 15.268(a) to consider a personnel matter. Motion carried.

The Township Board returned from closed session at 6:04 P.M.

Item 2 – DISCUSSION OF MAINTENANCE TRACTOR

Chief Obreiter was present for a discussion of a compact tractor for maintenance. The Board discussed the price options. Several members thought the Township should go for the 'whole package', including heated cab and mower.

The emergency electrical generators for Eastwood and Lakewood were discussed.

Item 3 – DISCUSSION OF GRASS AND SIDEWALK ORDINANCE AMENDMENTS

Discussion of grass and sidewalk ordinance amendments. The Board will go ahead with the grass length amendment. The Board asked our attorney to come up with a version that separated construction standards from performance standards for sidewalks.

Item 4 – STRATEGIC PLAN DISCUSSION

The Board discussed adoption of the strategic plan. Trustee Leuty provided some notes from our previous discussion that can be added as edits to the Plan.

Item 5 – DISCUSSION REGARDING ITEMS ON THE REGULAR AGENDA

Discussion of Consumer's Ordinances: Attorney Seeber explained the reasons for the changes Attorney Thall had made to the draft Ordinance provided by Consumers.

Manager Mitchell reported on the AR-15 purchases and dispositions of old ones, and some recent Taser employments by Township Police. Township Police and Fire are eager to host Board members for ride-alongs.

The regular meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Charter Township of Kalamazoo, Kalamazoo County, was held at 7:30 p.m., Monday, January 8, 2018, at the Charter Township of Kalamazoo Administrative Offices, 1720 Riverview Drive, Kalamazoo, Michigan 49004-1099.

Item 1 CALL TO ORDER

Supervisor Martin called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m.

Item 2 PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

Trustee Leuty led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Item 3 ROLL CALL OF BOARD MEMBERS

All Board Members were present.

Item 4 ADDITIONS AND DELETIONS TO AGENDA

Treasurer Miller asked to remove Item B (Minutes of December 11, 2017, Board of Trustees Regular Meeting) from the Consent Agenda and move to Item 10 of the Regular Agenda.

Item 5 PUBLIC COMMENT ON AGENDA AND NON-AGENDA ITEMS

There were no public comments.

Item 6 CONSENT AGENDA

Clerk Miller moved, seconded by Trustee Leigh, to approve the consent agenda which included action on the following items:

Item 7 PUBLIC HEARINGS

There were no public hearings.

Item 8 UNFINISHED BUSINESS

There was no unfinished business.

Item 9 NEW BUSINESS

Item 9A **FIRST READING OF CONSUMERS ENERGY COMPANY GAS ORDINANCE**

Township Attorney Seeber provided an overview of the proposed Consumers Energy Company Gas Franchise Ordinance. She explained that two ordinances have been prepared for Consumers Energy Company, one for electric and one for gas. The term shortened from 30 years to 10 years, and several provisions favorable to the township included.

The Ordinance would grant a non-exclusive franchise to Consumers Energy Company to use local public ways and provide a local gas business.

Trustee Hathcock moved, seconded by Trustee Strebs, to accept for first reading the proposed Consumers Energy Company Gas Franchise Ordinance. Motion carried.

Item 9B **FIRST READING OF CONSUMERS ENERGY COMPANY ELECTRIC ORDINANCE**

The Consumer Energy Company Electric Franchise Ordinance would grant Consumers Energy Company, its successors and assigns, the right, power and authority to construct, maintain, and commercially use electric lines consisting of towers, masts, poles, crossarms, guys, braces, feeders, transmission and distribution wires, transformers and other electrical appliances on, under, along and across the highways, streets, alleys, bridges, waterways, and other public places, and to transact a local electric business in the Charter Township of Kalamazoo for a period of 10 years.

Trustee Hathcock moved, seconded by Trustee Strebs, to accept for first reading the proposed Consumers Energy Company Electric Franchise Ordinance. Motion carried.

Item 9C **FIRST READING OF ORDINANCE AMENDMENTS FOR SIDEWALK CLEARING AND GRASS HEIGHT**

The sidewalk clearing amendment has been removed for further consideration; however, the grass height ordinance has a proposed change to the permitted height.

Trustee Leuty moved, seconded by Treasurer Miller, to accept the proposed amendments of the Noxious Weeds provisions of the Charter Township of Kalamazoo Code of Ordinances to change the permitted height from 12 inches to 8 inches. Motion carried.

Item 9D **FIRE DEPARTMENT REQUEST TO AUTHORIZE PURCHASE OF STATION EMERGENCY GENERATOR REPLACEMENT**

Supervisor Martin moved, seconded by Trustee Strebs, to authorize the purchase and installation of two emergency power generators and electrical system upgrades as specified by Wolverine Power Systems of Zeeland, Michigan, for the total price of \$80,000; and to authorize the Township Manager to sign the contract and paperwork associated with the project. Motion carried.

Item 9E **REQUEST TO PURCHASE COMPACT TRACTOR FOR MAINTENANCE**

Supervisor Martin moved, seconded by Trustee Leigh, to authorize the purchase of a John Deere 1025R Sub-compact utility tractor with the following options: two-stage snow blower, 54 inch front blade, 52 inch rotary broom, front end loader attachment, and cab with wiper as quoted from Steensma Lawn and Power Equipment of Kalamazoo, Michigan, for the state bid price of \$29,090.76; and to authorize the township Manager to sign all project associated contracts.

It was noted that this project has been budgeted for in the fire department capital improvement budget; and that the Board recommended the hard sided cab with cover for protection from the elements, safety, and to provide effective service to the community.

Motion carried.

Item 9F REQUEST TO APPROVE 2018 STRATEGIC PLAN

Supervisor Martin moved, seconded by Clerk Miller, to approve the 2018 Strategic Plan for the Charter Township of Kalamazoo. Motion carried.

Item 9G REQUEST TO ADJUST MANAGER'S SALARY

The Township Manager's agreement with the Township of Kalamazoo provides that based on merit, the Board will consider an increase in the manager's salary. Manager Mitchell provided a written summary of his 2017 goals and outcomes. They include personal development, economics, customer service (both inside and outside the office), partnerships, and acknowledge personnel changes in 2017. It concluded that Manager Mitchell has completed a majority of his goals, will continue to push forward into 2018 and beyond, and is thankful for the opportunity to serve this community.

Supervisor Martin moved, seconded by Trustee Leigh, to increase the salary of the Township Manager by \$3000 per the initial contract.

The Board recognized the contractual obligation, as well as thanked and commended Manager Mitchell for his excellent performance, team focus and ability to elevate township moral.

Motion carried.

Item 10 ITEMS REMOVED FROM CONSENT AGENDA

Clerk Miller amended Item 10H, Request Regarding Kalamazoo Area Building Authority 2018 Budget, in the December 11, 2017, Regular Meeting Minutes by striking "of \$4200.26" from the first line to now read "Supervisor Martin gave a brief history of the Kalamazoo Area Building Authority (KABA), and noted that the budget for KABA indicates a deficit for 2018".

Clerk Miller moved, seconded by Treasurer Miller, to approve the Minutes of December 11, 2017 Board of Trustees Regular Meeting, as amended. Motion carried.

Item 11 COMMITTEE REPORTS

Trustee Hathcock reported on the Planning commission meeting that was held on January 4, 2018. Topics of discussion included Panse Greenhouse rezoning and the Medical Marihuana draft ordinance. He also said that there will be a Special Planning Commission Meeting on January 18, 2018, at 7:00 p.m. to discuss the Medical Marihuana Ordinance.

Trustee Leigh attended a Kalamazoo Area Transportation Study (KATS) meeting and commented on discussion regarding County Brownfield and solar light farms, and reminded people to be careful when passing MDOT trucks.

Trustee Leuty is thankful for the new noxious weeds ordinance. He also said that Zoning Board of Appeal (ZBA) meetings have a set schedule for the third Wednesday of every month at 7:00 p.m. at the Kalamazoo Township Hall, pending items on the agenda.

Supervisor Martin reported that the Executive Director and Assistant Director of the Kalamazoo County Consolidated Dispatch Authority (KCCDA) are at their new location, 7040 Stadium Drive. Additionally, he commented that Public Media Network (PMN) filmed the swearing in of new Kalamazoo Township Police Chief Bryan Ergang. Lastly, he invited and encouraged everyone to attend the open house for the Road Commission of Kalamazoo County (RCKC) on Wednesday, January 10, 2018, at the Township of Kalamazoo.

Manager Mitchell will attend the Kalamazoo Area Transportation Study (KATS) Technical meeting on Thursday, January 11, 2018. He also again thanked former Police Chief Timothy Bourgeois and welcomed the new Police Chief Bryan Ergang. He noted that the Township police department will have three openings to fill throughout the year.

Item 12 **ATTORNEY’S REPORT**

Attorney Seeber commented on the Kalamazoo County Planned Unit Development (PUD) relative to the new Kalamazoo County Animal Shelter.

Item 12A **MANAGER REPORT**

Manager Mitchell was pleased with the recent meeting with the City of Kalamazoo, City of Portage, and the Township of Kalamazoo reference the Medical Marijuana Ordinance. He shared that the Borgess Run for the Health of it will take place on May 6, 2018; and that the Township of Kalamazoo is currently accepting applications for the position of Administrative Clerk/Cashier.

Item 13 **PUBLIC COMMENTS**

Kyle Barker, 1210 Crown Street, asked for permitted use versus special use permits for the Medical Marijuana Ordinance.

Item 14 **BOARD MEMBER COMMENTS**

The Board wished everyone a Happy New Year.

Trustee Strebs commented that 2017 was a year of change and hopes to see a prosperous 2018.

Trustee Hathcock reported that the Kalamazoo County Animal Shelter will have larger kennels. He also shared his excitement for the Eastwood Community Garden.

Trustee Leigh would like to continue to see involvement and feedback from the community. She also shared that on Monday, January 15, 2018, in honor of Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Day, Western Michigan University is celebrating with a number of activities including an all-day educational seminar and a march to MLK Park. She also added that the Women’s March on Washington is scheduled to take place on January 21, 2018.

Clerk Miller added that the location for the January 15, 2018, Martin Luther King Celebration event is at the Western Michigan University Bernhard Center.

Treasurer Miller encouraged both residents and businesses to attend Neighborhood Association Meetings.

Trustee Leuty commented on the positivity of community events, a great way to get to know your neighbors. He also reminded residents to clear the snow around fire hydrants. Also, he was moved by the swearing-in ceremony for the incoming Police Chief Bryan Ergang.

Supervisor Martin added that there were a number of residents, former officers, board members and family in attendance at the swearing-in ceremony.

Item 15 ADJOURNMENT

There being no further business to come before the Board, the meeting was adjourned at 8:13 p.m.

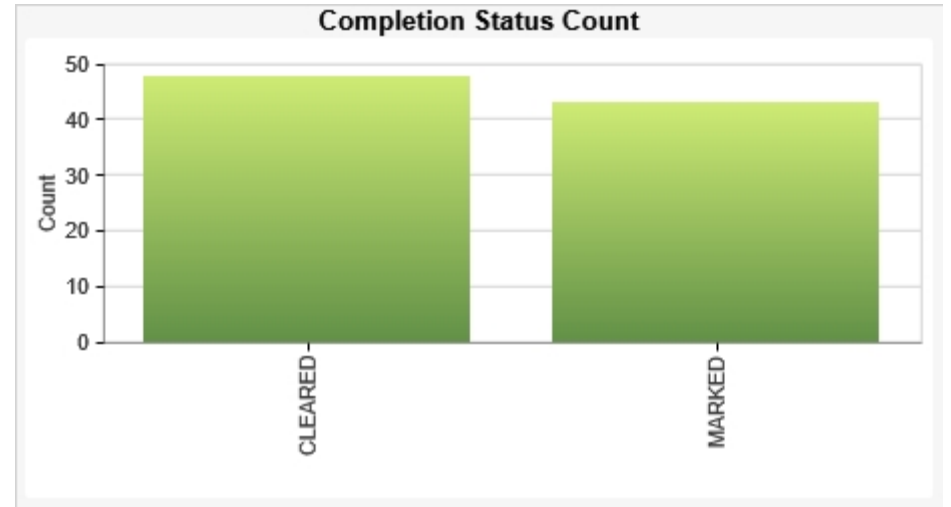
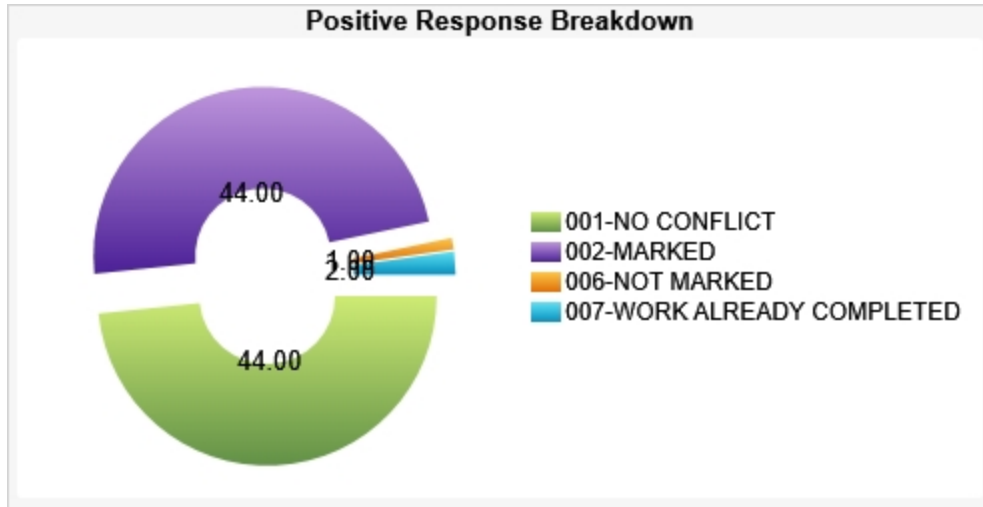

SECTION I

GRANT OF NON-EXCLUSIVE RIGHTS

A. Grant and Term. The Charter Township of Kalamazoo, Kalamazoo County, Michigan ("Township"), grants to Consumers Energy Company ("Grantee"), its successors and assigns, subject to the terms and conditions set forth below, the non-exclusive right, power and authority to construct, maintain and commercially use electric lines consisting of towers, masts, poles, cross-arms, guys, braces, feeders, transmission and distribution wires, transformers and other electrical appliances (hereinafter "Electric System") on, along, across, over and under the public highways, streets, alleys, bridges, waterways, and other public places (hereinafter also referred to as "Public Ways") and to transact a local electric business, within the Township for a period of ten (10) years.

SECTION II
USE OF PUBLIC RIGHTS-OF-WAY BY GRANTEE

A. No Burden on Public Ways. Grantee and its contractors, subcontractors and the Grantee's Electric System shall not unduly burden or interfere with the present or future use of any of the Public Ways within the Township. Grantee shall install and maintain its Electric System so as to cause minimum interference with the use of the Public Ways. No Public Way shall be obstructed longer than necessary during the work of construction or repair to the Electric System. Grantee's cable, wires, structures and equipment shall be suspended or buried so as to not endanger or injure persons or property in the Public Ways.

B. Restoration of Public Ways. Grantee and its contractors and subcontractors shall within a reasonable time restore, at Grantee's sole cost and expense, any portion of the Public Ways that is in any way disturbed, damaged, or injured by the construction, operation, maintenance or removal of the Electric System to as good or better condition than that which existed prior to the disturbance. In the event that Grantee, its contractors or subcontractors fail to make such repair within a reasonable time specified by the Township, the Township shall, among other remedies, be entitled to have the repair completed and Grantee shall pay the costs for such repair.

C. Easements. Any easements over or under property owned by the Township in fee shall be separately negotiated with the Township.

D. Compliance with Laws. Grantee shall comply with all applicable laws, statutes, ordinances, rules and regulations regarding its Electric System, whether federal, state or local, now in force or which hereafter may be promulgated. Nothing herein shall be construed as a waiver by Grantee of any of its existing or future rights under state or federal law.

E. Tree Clearing. Grantee may clear trees upon and overhanging the Public Ways so as to prevent trees from coming into contact with the Electric System in accordance with the tree clearing standards of Grantee and the applicable requirements of the MPSC. Except in an emergency, no clearing shall be done in the Public Ways without previously informing the Township.

F. Street Vacation. Grantee accrues no rights under this franchise which would impair the rights of the Township to vacate or consent to the vacation of a Public Way.

G. Company Representative. The Grantee shall designate an employee to act as a representative to respond to inquiries from the Township regarding the administration of this franchise and the obligations and services herein. The Grantee shall provide the Township with the person's name and telephone number.

H. Notice. Before commencing the construction or repair work on its Electric System which will require excavation in or the closing of any street, alley, bridge, waterway or other public place, the Grantee shall provide the Township with notice, including a description of the work to

be performed, in advance of such work. This notice requirement shall not apply to the installation of electric services on privately owned property nor to any other work performed on such privately owned property. Nothing herein shall preclude the Grantee from immediately commencing construction or repair work within any street, alley, bridge, waterway or other public place when deemed necessary due to an emergency or service restoration, and in such case, the Grantee shall notify the Township of such work if reasonably practical.

SECTION III **HOLD HARMLESS**

The Grantee shall at all times keep and save the Township free and harmless from all loss, costs and expense to which it may become subject by reason of the construction, maintenance and operation of the structures and equipment hereby authorized. In case any action is commenced against the Township on account of the permission herein granted, said Grantee shall, upon notice, defend the Township and save it free and harmless from all loss, cost and damage arising out of said permission. Providing further, that this hold harmless agreement shall not apply to any loss, cost, damage or claims arising solely out of the negligence of the Township, its employees or its contractors. Furthermore, in the event that any loss, cost, damage or claims arise out of the joint negligence of the Township, its employees or its contractors, this hold harmless agreement shall not apply to the proportional extent of the negligence of the Township, its employees or its contractors. Notwithstanding any provision contained in this Ordinance, nothing in this Ordinance shall impair any liability protection afforded the Township pursuant to law.

SECTION IV **REVOCAION**

The franchise granted by this Ordinance is subject to revocation upon sixty (60) days written notice by the party desiring such revocation.

SECTION V **RATES**

Grantee shall be entitled to charge the inhabitants of the Township for electricity furnished at the rates approved by the Michigan Public Service Commission, to the extent it or its successors, have authority and jurisdiction to fix and regulate electric rates and promulgate rules regulating such service in the Township. Such rates and rules shall be subject to review at any time upon petition being made by either the Township acting through the Township Board or by Grantee.

SECTION VI **TOWNSHIP JURISDICTION**

Said Grantee shall be and remain subject to all ordinances, rules and regulations of the Township now in effect, or which might subsequently be adopted for the regulation of land uses or for the protection of the health, safety and general welfare of the public; provided however, that

nothing herein shall be construed as a waiver by Grantee of any of its existing or future rights under state or federal law.

SECTION VII
MICHIGAN PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION

Grantee shall, as to all other conditions and elements of service not addressed or fixed by this Ordinance, remain subject to the rules and regulations applicable to electric service by the Michigan Public Service Commission, or its successor bodies to the extent such jurisdiction applies.

Grantee shall reimburse the Township for reasonable actual costs incurred in the review of a request by Grantee for approval.

Please find attached the amendment to the original contract for services for the 2018 calendar year. In 2017, the amount of funding allotted by your municipality was \$ 16,400.00. When making allotments for 2018, please consider the following items:

1. The contract with ERG Environmental Services has been extended for another year and disposal costs increased from \$0.60/pound to \$0.64/pound.
2. The contract with Valley City has been extended for 2018 and the fees for recycling electronic waste were not increased. In the past, electronic recycling costs were extremely low because all the components were in demand. However, more CRT glass as well as plastic is being collected than is being re-used so there remains a high cost for recycling CRT monitors and TVs.
3. Operation costs for 2018 will be billed and subtracted in January from the funding allotment you provide. The remainder of the allotment is used for disposal costs and is billed to you each quarter. Participation has continued to steadily increase which in turn increases disposal costs. We recommend an increase in your 2018 allotment to prevent running out of funds later in the year. Remember, the County does not actually hold any of the allotment. If there is unused funding at the end of 2018, that money remains with your municipality.

Please return both copies filled out and signed. Once executed, we will return one signed amendment to you for your records. We look forward to another successful year of collections and working with your municipality toward the common goal of groundwater protection and landfill use reduction.

**AMENDMENT #2 TO THE AGREEMENT
BETWEEN THE COUNTY OF KALAMAZOO
BY AND THROUGH ITS HEALTH AND COMMUNITY SERVICES DEPARTMENT**

AND

Kalamazoo Township

The County of Kalamazoo and Kalamazoo Township having previously entered into an AGREEMENT dated 3/15/2016, for the purpose of providing household hazardous waste disposal services; said AGREEMENT was amended on 2/7/2017; do now hereby approve and agree to amend the existing AMENDMENT as follows:

a) Section C. FINANCIAL REQUIREMENTS

1. Under the terms of this Agreement, the MUNICIPALITY will provide funding to a maximum amount of \$ 17,000.00 (C.1.) to the County for services at the HHW Center. Of this total, the following allocations will be made:
 2. a. \$ 6,888.00 of the total amount in C.1. will be invoiced in January of 2018 for operating costs. This amount equates to a per household equivalent participation rate of \$7.00 (20% of operational costs) applied to 2016 household equivalent participation volume. Operational costs are non-refundable regardless of actual participation at the HHW Center and shall be paid in full within thirty (30) days of receipt of HCS FMA billing invoice.
 - b. \$ 8,500.00 of the total amount in C.1. will be reserved for service fees and disposal costs of items directly from **MUNICIPALITY Buildings and Offices** which will be accepted by appointment only. HCS FMA will submit a quarterly invoice and will indicate charges, if any, for use of the HHW Center by the MUNICIPALITY. The MUNICIPALITY shall pay the invoice amount to the County within thirty (30) days of the invoice date.
 - c. The remainder of the total amount of C.1. minus amounts in C.2.a. and C.2.b. will be used for disposal costs associated with the disposal of household hazardous wastes from the MUNICIPALITY's citizens. Costs charged to the MUNICIPALITY for utilization of the household hazardous waste collection services by its citizens will be based upon the number of household equivalents from the MUNICIPALITY and disposal costs during the billing period.
3. The County will provide an itemized quarterly report to each participating MUNICIPALITY in the Household Hazardous Waste program. The report will serve as the basis for accounting of the funds provided to the County for the HHW Center. The quarterly report will be provided within forty-five (45) days of the end of the quarter.

b) Section K. PERIOD OF AGREEMENT

The term of this Agreement shall be from January 1, 2018 through December 31, 2018, unless terminated earlier as provided.

The individual or officer signing this AMENDMENT certifies by his/her signature that he/she is authorized to sign this AMENDMENT on behalf of the responsible governing board, official or agency. All other terms of the previously approved AGREEMENT remain unchanged and are reincorporated herein as if fully set forth in this AMENDMENT.

For the last 13 months, an informal committee consisting of myself, Manager Mitchell and Tammy Durian has been investigating various options for implementing electronic document management in the township. At some of the presentations by vendors, others representing various township departments have been present as well.

STATEMENT OF NEED

Over the last year, I have spent a little time on most days throwing away paper records that have long passed their retention period as mandated under state of Michigan regulations. Even after that, much more remains to be done, and many file boxes in the vault and elsewhere contain a mixture of records, which may or may not be reflected in the label on the outside of the box. As an example, in the course of throwing away minutes of MTA committee meetings from the 1980s, I found the original deed for the township golf course. Dozens of file boxes are not cataloged, so the records in them cannot be located when needed, and may as well not exist.

We routinely spend more time than should be necessary in fulfilling FOIA requests. In a few cases of building department records, we had to finally inform requesting parties that records could not be found, despite the fact that we are obligated to retain those record classes. The existing filing system for contracts and agreements is a mixture of alphabetical and topical, requiring several tries (at least) to find where a given file is located.

The existing "shared" drive on our server is a junk drawer of folders created by nearly every township employee, with no overall system. A number of folders within this drive are of unknown origin.

Making multiple paper copies of documents is a considerable expense that if avoided, could partly offset the cost of a document management system.

BENEFITS

Document management software would have the following benefits:

- Newly-created documents would be 'printed' directly to an image file, saving paper. Optical character recognition (OCR) would automatically be performed, allowing for search of any content. Recurring forms would automatically be indexed on fields contained within them. Search can be carried out on multiple index fields at the same time.
- Existing paper documents can be scanned, OCR and indexing of recognized fields carried out automatically.

- Email can be stored within the system, indexed appropriately so that (for example) a message concerning a property will be returned along with all other relevant documents when the address is searched.
- Permissions can be set so that one employee has the right to look at a class of documents, another to edit or delete them, another to create new folders within the file structure. All permissions can be assigned to a pre-defined role, with employees assigned to that role.
- Retention dates can be assigned to a folder or to individual documents.
- Documents can be redacted by adding rectangles over redacted text prior to distribution, without deleting the underlying information on the master copy.
- Annotations can be added to documents by multiple individuals, allowing for approvals or comments to be made.
- Work flows can be set up, allowing a document to pass from one person to another after necessary action has been taken. If a document has not been acted on in a preset interval, it can automatically be routed to a supervisor.
- Web forms can be created, allowing members of the public to complete and submit various applications without a trip to the township office.

Some of these functions may be available only with additional add-ons, depending on which system is chosen.

There are lists of a hundred or so competing document management packages. In the end, we chose to evaluate five different systems/vendors which appear to be marketing towards Michigan local governments:

- 1) Shumaker Technology Group
<https://www.shumakergroup.com/document-management/index.php>

This is a local Michigan company that has developed its own product called 'content central'. They made a webinar presentation to us, in which they demonstrated their product. Our impression, based on our familiarity with competing products, was that this was a fairly 'bare bones' offering, without many of the features available from competing systems.

- 2) ICompass Records Manager
<https://www.icompasstech.com/solutions/records-manager/>

This solution had some attractive features, but was implemented as a cloud-only solution. We made the decision that since we need to own our own server anyhow, we may as well avoid significant hosting fees a cloud-based solution entails.

For the remaining three options, we made site visits to local government entities which had adopted each. We also got price quotes from each.

- 3) FileBound, represented locally by Adams Remco
<https://uplandsoftware.com/filebound/>

After a presentation here at our Township Hall, we visited the Kalamazoo County Environmental Health Department to see their implementation of FileBound. It appeared to us that their use of

the system was limited to only a few classes of tasks, and more importantly that the look and feel of the user interface was not as intuitive as the two remaining systems discussed below. For example, there is an arbitrary limit of three levels of folders. While we could make this work, I can think of cases where more would be better.

- 4) DocWare, represented locally by Hasselbring-Clark (now acquired by Applied Imaging)
<http://www.appliedimaging.com/>

This is an attractive option, including the fact that Mari Martin, who works for Hasselbring-Clark, would be our trainer and consultant. The DocuWare package seems intuitive and versatile, and Mari is an extremely engaging person. The cost is also considerably less than for our last option, Laserfiche.

We visited the offices of the City of Alma, Michigan, where DocuWare is being implemented. What we found was that in spite of having what seems to be a superior product, and a dynamic trainer, staff was still struggling to implement many of the features of the product. Some were ahead of others, but the overall impression is that the transition to a full implementation is requiring a significant effort.

This is a cautionary tale for us. We certainly don't want to spend the money on a system only to have it languish.

It is also unclear to me how the very recent (January 2) acquisition of Hasselbring-Clark by Applied Imaging will affect the availability and support of DocuWare. The Applied Imaging site does not mention DocuWare, only a competing product we have not evaluated, OnBase.

- 5) Laserfiche, represented locally by General Code
<https://www.laserfiche.com/products/>

Of the products we evaluated, Laserfiche appears to be the most professional, most widely adopted, with the strongest support and training. The major advantage I see with Laserfiche is not so much features and interface, although these are superior to all the others we have looked at. It is the depth of support, a network of personnel who would be available to us. Additionally, Laserfiche has literally hundreds of training videos (and many other resources), mainly very short, tightly focused on explaining one task. I see this as a strong advantage as we are implementing the package across all our departments and processes.

We visited Oshtemo Township, which is in the process of implementing Laserfiche across all of their departments. Here again, the process is not without some difficulties. It requires considerable re-imagining of how common tasks are carried out. Dusty Farmer, my colleague at Oshtemo, is determined to see this through. She is leading the process, and they have made considerable progress. We would have the advantage of collaborating with Oshtemo and learning from what they have done.

Realistically, we cannot evaluate how each of the hundreds of features and all the other aspects of these packages compare to each other from an hour spent looking at someone else using them. We do have the advantage of a detailed head-to-head comparison of DocuWare and

Laserfiche, compiled by an independent source, based on a large number of reviews. If you wish to look at this comparison, it is at: <https://www.g2crowd.com/compare/docuware-vs-laserfiche>

Dozens of features are compared, with Laserfiche having the advantage on almost all features. The overall score was 3.5 for DocuWare, 4.5 for Laserfiche.

Recommendation: I think that we should proceed to work with General Code to define specifications and get a firm quote for an implementation of Laserfiche. The attached quote, as stated, is preliminary.

The significant factors in my recommendation are:

- 1) The size and strength of the company
- 2) Our impression of the competing products.
- 3) The head-to-head review above.
- 4) Seeing how implementation is proceeding at our site visits.
- 5) Depth of training offered, and online training materials available.

I believe that this will make a major improvement in both the efficiency and effectiveness of business processes in our township.
