The Board of Trustees of the *Charter Township of Kalamazoo* held a Work Session on <u>Monday, May 13, 2019</u> at <u>5:30 p.m</u>. in the Board Room of the Charter Township of Kalamazoo Administration Building, 1720 Riverview Drive, Kalamazoo, Michigan 49004-1099, for the purpose of discussing Work Session Agenda items, and any other business that may legally come before the Board of Trustees of the Charter Township of Kalamazoo, Kalamazoo County.

Supervisor Martin called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m.

Item 1 - RECREATIONAL MARIJUANA IN KALAMAZOO TOWNSHIP

Manager Mitchell discussed the handouts provided from the Michigan Municipal League, and the background to the Michigan Regulation and Taxation of Marihuana Act (MRTMA). There was discussion about many aspects of the new law. The Board and Attorney Seeber discussed the idea of adopting an ordinance opting out of the commercial recreational aspects, while we wait for some clarity to emerge from the legal process, versus a moratorium which would require later action by the Board. Attorney Seeber will provide a draft ordinance.

Item 2 - DISCUSSION REGARDING ITEMS ON THE REGULAR AGENDA

Trustee Leigh asked a few questions on the Police Annual Report. Chief Ergang explained that Part 2 crimes are lesser crimes like vandalism. We are seeing a rise in opioid overdoses and methamphetamine. Trustee Strebs wondered whether we could have additional reporting on what the school resource officers are accomplishing.

Item 1 CALL TO ORDER

Supervisor Martin called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m.

Item 2 PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

Trustee Leuty led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Item 3 ROLL CALL OF BOARD MEMBERS

Trustee Hathcock was absent. Clerk Miller moved to excuse Trustee Hathcock, seconded by Treasurer Miller. Motion carried.

Item 4 ADDITIONS AND DELETIONS TO AGENDA

None.

<u>Item 5</u> <u>PUBLIC COMMENT ON AGENDA AND NON-AGENDA ITEMS</u>

Antonia Kennedy, 1114 Arthur Ave., commented on the great Borgess Run, an opportunity to showcase the Eastwood neighborhood. She thanked the Police and Fire Departments for their work. She invited the Township Board to an event August 24, 12-4 in the afternoon. This will be for Eastwood neighborhood and all elected officials representing us. There will be a food drive.

Ron Huster, 1314 Coolidge, spoke about the City change in their fireworks ordinance reducing the number of allowed days. City has approved "Shared Streets" Ordinance.

Treasurer Miller pointed out that the application for the community party was not signed, and asked that the April 22 minutes be amended to reflect that the Treasurer and Deputy Treasurer were scheduled to be at a conference during the audit.

There was debate to clarify what was meant by the request, and how to handle the request.

Supervisor Martin moved to remove the April 22 minutes from the Consent Agenda, seconded by Treasurer Miller. Motion carried.

The pending motion to approve the remainder of the Consent Agenda was then carried.

Item 9 NEW BUSINESS

Item 9A REQUEST TO PURCHASE TWO POLICE PATROL VEHICLES

Manager Mitchell detailed the purchase proposal. These will be Ford Interceptor SUVs. This is part of the Michigan MIdeal. Total cost will be \$74,768. The funds will come out of the Police Capital Fund. **Trustee Leigh moved, seconded by Trustee Leuty, to approve the purchase.**

Trustee Leuty mentioned that Signature Ford from Owosso was the only dealership that participated in the MIdeal program, which was the only reason we are not buying locally.

Supervisor Martin appreciates that we are going to all-wheel drive vehicles, and the fact that these come ready to install specialized equipment.

Motion carried.

Item 9B REQUEST TO PURCHASE 40 POUND COMMERCIAL GEAR WASHER

Supervisor Martin explained the proposal for heavy a duty washer for fire gear.

Trustee Strebs moved, seconded by Trustee Leuty, to approve the purchase for \$9992.

In answer to a question by Trustee Leigh, Supervisor Martin clarified that this will be at our Northwood Station, and used by all stations. Trustee Leigh also clarified that this is under the Fire Capital Fund. Trustee Leuty referenced a recent talk explaining the number of hazardous chemicals firefighters come into contact with.

Motion carried.

<u>Item 10A</u> <u>Minutes of April 22, 2019 Board of Trustees Regular Meeting</u>

Treasurer Miller moved, seconded by Trustee Leuty, to amend the minutes to reflect the fact that she had said that she would be out of the office during the audit.

Roll call vote, 2 ayes (Treasurer Miller, Leuty), 4 nays. Motion defeated.

Clerk Miller moved, seconded by Trustee Leigh, to approve the April 22 minutes as presented.

Roll call vote, 5 ayes, 1 nay (Treasurer Miller).

Item 11 BOARD MEMBER REPORTS

Trustee Strebs mentioned Public Media Network's opportunity for training for non-profits. May 2 was the one-year anniversary of Kalamazoo County ID project, with 1900 IDs issued in the first year.

Trustee Leigh discussed the KATS meeting on 4/24, supporting action on bridge projects. Discussion about coordination between entities in a road project, including all utilities. CCTA discussed OPEB liabilities. RFPs are being issued for Metro Connect and for a Connect Trainer to teach constituents how to ride the busses. Police Department has released their annual report; citations went down by 700, also 140 fewer car accidents. Housing millage passed by County several years ago, Commissioner Hall shared that we helped 106 families in March alone. She hears that the Parchment firefighters love Chief Obreiter, and that our police services for Parchment are going well.

Clerk Miller discussed plans to share more information on our website. He promoted Kalamazoo Bike Week, in progress.

Treasurer Miller said that under MBIA Class \$4992.42, interest on tax dollars was inadvertently acquired, that will be disbursed to the proper taxing authorities. There was also some interest that needs to be disbursed from Chemical Bank as well.

Trustee Leuty praised Mike Major on the good job of cleaning parks. ZBA meets this Wednesday; on the agenda is a request for a variance for setback at 3738 E Main St, medical marihuana provisioning center. Grass is growing, needs to be cut. The Board discussed recreational marihuana this evening, We need to act positively to opt out if we wish to.

Supervisor Martin reminded Board members to use Item 4, Additions and Deletions to Agenda, if needed. He thanked the Board for the gear washer. He is looking forward to the August 24 Wilson Park party. Today is the anniversary of the tornado in Kalamazoo Township.

Item 12 ATTORNEY'S REPORT

Their firm has moved to Portage and is settling in.

Item 13 MANAGER REPORT

Thanked the Board for the two police vehicles. They are working on the Nixel system (early warning system). He will be at the Westwood Neighborhood Association meeting this week, presenting on recreational marihuana. Swearing in of newest policy officer will be on May 20. The Manager continues to work on police recruitment and engagement with other local groups. Kalamazoo Township was highlighted in the MTA's "Township Focus", based on Trustee Leuty's final project for the Township Governance Academy.

INDUSTRIAL FACILITIES TAX EXEMPTION AGREEMENT

AND AFFIDAVIT

AGREEMENT made this _____ day of May, 2019, by and between the **KALAMAZOO CHARTER TOWNSHIP**, Kalamazoo County, Michigan (hereinafter "Township"); and Kalsec, Inc. (hereinafter "Applicant").

WHEREAS, the Township received an application from Applicant for the issuance of an Industrial Facilities Tax Exemption Certificate for its proposed improvements within an Industrial Development District heretofore established by the Township Board of said Township;

WHEREAS, Public Act 266 of 1994 requires a written agreement between the Township and the Applicant before an Industrial Facilities Exemption Certificate can be approved by the Department of Treasury;

WHEREAS, the Township through its Township Board has passed a Resolution approving in whole or in part the granting of the Applicant's application for an Industrial Facilities Exemption Certificate subject to the Applicant entering into the within Agreement;

NOW, THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION of the approval of the said Industrial Facilities Exemption Certificate and the commitments contained herein, it is hereby agreed by and between the parties hereto as follows:

- 1. As a result of said improvements, not less than two (2) new jobs shall be created at the facility within two (2) years of the completion of the project for which said Industrial Facilities Exemption Certificate was issued and shall maintain these new jobs as well as the applicant's current fifty (50) jobs at the facility during the term of the Certificate. Failure to hire and maintain these positions shall be considered a material breach of this Agreement.
- 2. The Applicant agrees to maintain the facility for the entire period of the Certificate within the Township and not to move or relocate the facility, business, or any portion of either outside the industrial development district without first obtaining the permission of the Township. If Applicant relocates the facility, business, or any portion of either outside the industrial development district during the period in which the Industrial Facilities Exemption Certificate is in effect, the applicant shall be liable to the Township for an amount equal to the difference between the industrial facilities tax to be paid by the owner or lessee of that facility for that facility for the tax years remaining under the Industrial Facilities Exemption Certificate that is in effect and the general ad valorem property tax that the Applicant would have paid if the Applicant did not have an Industrial Facilities Exemption Certificate in effect for those years. For purposes of calculating the amount due hereunder, the taxable value of the facility shall be the same as was in effect at the time the facility was relocated outside the industrial development district. The payment provided in this section shall be distributed in the same manner as the industrial facilities tax is distributed.

- 3. In consideration of the benefits of an Industrial Facilities Exemption Certificate, Applicant agrees that the personal property that is described on the Application and is subject to tax exemption shall remain within the designated Industrial Development District during the term of the Industrial Facilities Exemption Certificate. The Applicant agrees to permit the Township access to the site to verify that the equipment is present, upon reasonable written notice by the Township. Removal of the personal property from the Industrial Development District and/or failure to permit Township access for verification shall constitute material breach of this Agreement.
- 4. The Applicant agrees to submit an annual project performance report to the Township addressed to the Township Clerk, provided under oath, setting forth the progress in attaining and maintaining the requirements of this Agreement and the provisions of the Certificate application. Such reports shall be furnished on or before July 1 of each year and shall contain, at a minimum, the following:
 - a. The number of new jobs promised in the Certificate and the actual number of new jobs created.
 - b. The number of employees at the time of the application and the current number of employees.
 - c. If the projection for creation or retention of jobs was not reached, give explanation.
 - d. The estimated project cost given in the application and the actual project cost.
 - e. If the actual project cost differs substantially from the projected cost, give explanation.
- 5. The Applicant agrees that if employment has not been retained or reached as represented, the construction and/or expansion project has not been completed or expenditures made as described in the Certificate application (which application is incorporated by reference as a part of this Agreement), or if the Applicant fails to fulfill any other provision of this Agreement as well as the provisions of Act 198 of 1974, as amended, the Township shall have the right to reduce the term or revoke the Certificate and Applicant shall repay to the Township and all taxing authorities the amount of taxes that were abated by reason of the Certificate.
- 6. Any payments due under this Agreement may be collected by either court proceedings or by adding to the next taxes due against the Applicant's property on the next tax roll of the Township.
- 7. If any of the various sections and provisions of this Agreement shall be declared by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of the Agreement as a whole or any section or provision hereof other than the section or provision so declared to be unconstitutional or invalid.

- 8. The parties agree that the Township, in approving the granting of the Certificate, has relied on the actions, representations and promises (including the Application) of the Applicant. Default of any provisions of this Agreement may be enforced in law and equity. The parties agree that exclusive jurisdiction to resolve any disputes on this Agreement shall be in Kalamazoo County, Michigan.
- 9. The parties acknowledge that the Township's fee for processing the Industrial Facilities Exemption Certificate is less than the actual cost of such processing and/or two percent (2%) of the property tax abated, and no other charges are collected by the Township from the Applicant for such processing.

By signatures of representatives of both the Applicant and the Township below, it is understood that both the Applicant's investment in the project and the Township's investment through the granting of a Certificate is to encourage economic growth. It is also acknowledged that certain economic conditions can, at times, prohibit the maintenance of the Applicant's targeted status. It is understood that if such conditions exist at the time of the designated Applicant reports, the governing body of the Township will carefully evaluate the Applicant's situation and will inform the Applicant if any action is being considered by the Township in order to give the Applicant an opportunity for correction.

RECREATIONAL MARIJUANA FACILITIES OPT OUT ORDINANCE

An ordinance to provide a title for the ordinance; to define words; to opt out of the operation of recreational marijuana facilities in Kalamazoo Township pursuant to requirements of Initiated Law 1 of 2018, MCL 333.27951 *et seq.*, as may be amended; to provide penalties for violation of this ordinance; to provide for severability; to repeal all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict therewith and to provide an effective date.

THE CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF KALAMAZOO KALAMAZOO COUNTY, MICHIGAN

ORDAINS:

SECTION I TITLE

This ordinance shall be known as and may be cited as the Kalamazoo Township Recreational Marijuana Facilities Opt Out Ordinance.

SECTION II DEFINITIONS

Words used herein shall have the definitions as provided for in Initiated Law 1 of 2018, MCL 333.27951 *et seq.*, as may be amended.

SECTION III NO AUTHORIZED RECREATIONAL MARIJUANA FACILITIES

Kalamazoo Township does not permit recreational marijuana facilities to operate within the township, and pursuant to the requirements of Initiated Law 1 of 2018, MCL 222.27951 *et seq.*, as may be amended, and the Rules promulgated thereunder, hereby prohibits all recreational marijuana facilities and establishments within the boundaries of Kalamazoo Township.

SECTION IV VIOLATIONS AND PENALTIES

1. Any person, firm, corporation or other entity who disobeys neglects or refuses to comply with any provision of this ordinance or who causes allows or consents to any of the same shall be deemed to be responsible for the violation of this ordinance. Any person, firm, corporation or other

entity who establishes a recreational marijuana facility in Kalamazoo Township shall be deemed to be in violation of this ordinance. A violation of this ordinance is deemed to be a nuisance per se.

- 2. A violation of this ordinance is a municipal civil infraction, for which the fines shall not be less than \$100 nor more than \$500, in the discretion of the Court. The foregoing sanctions shall be in addition to the rights of the Township to proceed at law or equity with other appropriate and proper remedies. Additionally, the violator shall pay costs which may include all expenses, direct and indirect, which the Township incurs in connection with the municipal civil infraction.
 - 3. Each day during which any violation continues shall be deemed a separate offense.
- 4. In addition, the Township may seek injunctive relief against persons alleged to be in violation of this ordinance, and such other relief as may be provided by law.
- 5. This ordinance shall be administered and enforced by the Zoning Administrator or Ordinance Enforcement Officer of the Township or by such other person (s) as designated by the Township Board from time to time.

SECTION V SEVERABLITY

The provisions of this ordinance are hereby declared to be severable. If any clause, sentence, word, section or provision is hereafter declared void or unenforceable for any reason by a court of competent jurisdiction, it shall not affect the remainder of such ordinance which shall continue in full force and effect. The provisions herein shall be construed as not interfering or conflicting with the statutory regulations for licensing marijuana facilities pursuant to Initiated Law 1 of 2018, as may be amended.

SECTION VI REPEAL

All ordinance or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

FIRE CONTRACT BETWEEN THE CITY OF PARCHMENT AND THE CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF KALAMAZOO

This agreement made _	, 2019, by and between the Charter	Township of
Kalamazoo (Township),	and the City of Parchment (City) both in Kalamazoo Coun	ty, Michigan.

WHEREAS, the Charter Township of Kalamazoo through the Charter Township of Kalamazoo Fire Department provides fire protection, and is possessed of equipment and personnel adequate to serve the fire protection needs of the City of Parchment; and

WHEREAS MCL 41.806 provides that "(i)f a township board, or the township boards of adjoining townships acting jointly, have organized and are maintaining a police or fire department, the board, or boards acting jointly, may also contract with townships, villages, or cities that also maintain a police or fire department or with any other person, organization, or group to provide police or fire apparatus, equipment, or personnel or police or fire protection within the City"; and

WHEREAS the City of Parchment has operated a fire department and is presently seeking a fire chief; and

WHEREAS in the absence of a chief, it is the desire of the City of Parchment to contract with the Charter Township of Kalamazoo for the provision of fire services and protection within the boundaries of the City of Parchment; and

WHEREAS, the Charter Township of Kalamazoo has the manpower and facilities for the provision of such fire protection to the City of Parchment while it seeks a new fire chief.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is agreed as follows:

- 1. The Charter Township of Kalamazoo through the Charter Township of Kalamazoo Fire Department agrees that it will provide fire protection for the people and property with the City of Parchment as established on the map attached hereto as Exhibit A for a period of six (6) months or until such time as City Manager notifies the Charter Township of Kalamazoo that the services under this contract are no longer needed. Such notice shall be provided not less than thirty days prior to the intended termination date of this contract.
- The Charter Township of Kalamazoo agrees to furnish fire and emergency medical response services equivalent to the fire protection, management and administrative duties related to services ordinarily rendered by fire departments servicing communities of a size comparable to the Charter Township of Kalamazoo and the City of Parchment.

- 3. The Charter Township of Kalamazoo Fire Department represents that is has the necessary emergency equipment and trained personnel to adequately provide for the response to fire and emergency medical incidents. The City of Parchment will continue to use City of Parchment personnel and equipment for all responses within the City of Parchment and as specified in any Initial or Mutual Aid Agreements currently in place with the City of Parchment.
- 4. The Charter Township of Kalamazoo shall provide the City of Parchment the services of a Fire Chief. The City of Parchment firefighters will work under the supervision of the Township of Kalamazoo Fire Chief. The Township of Kalamazoo Fire Chief will be responsible for the following: administrative duties to include required reporting, fire department training, fire and medical responses and any other duties normally undertaken by the Fire Department's Fire Chief.
- 5. The Charter Township of Kalamazoo Fire Department shall use its best efforts to respond to all requests for response related to fire and emergency medical incidents. In the event that the Charter Township of Kalamazoo Fire Department shall be unable to respond to a request for service because of previous commitments which may prevent or delay the deployment of resources, there shall be no liability of any kind or nature on the part of the Charter Township of Kalamazoo Fire Department.
- 6. The City and Township shall execute such documents as are necessary to ensure that the Charter Township of Kalamazoo Fire Department is designated by 9-1-1 as the fire services provider for the City.
- 7. That for and in consideration of fire protection, City of Parchment agrees to provide a total monthly operating payment of three thousand five hundred (\$3,500) for each month commencing on the first day of each month for fire protection services for the following month.
- 8. That the Charter Township of Kalamazoo Fire Department shall maintain such insurance as will adequately protect it from claim(s) under the Worker's Compensation Disability Act and from claim(s) for damages because of bodily injury, including death, or from any other liability for its operation under this contract, whether such operation be by the Kalamazoo Charter Township Fire Department or by anyone directly or indirectly employed by them.
- 9. City shall provide for the preservation and securing of premises located within its community after the Charter Township of Kalamazoo Fire Department services are rendered and after the Kalamazoo Charter Township Fire Department has left the scene.
- 10. It is agreed that when any equipment or personnel from the Charter Township of Kalamazoo Fire Department responds to any call for service within the City of Parchment, all of the fire equipment and all of the personnel shall be under the command of the Charter Township of Kalamazoo Fire Department.

- 11. It is further agreed that the Charter Township of Kalamazoo Fire Department shall not be liable to the City or any residents thereof for damages to persons or property necessarily or accidentally incurred at the scene of or while operating in conjunction with an emergency incident where members of the Charter Township of Kalamazoo Fire Department are engaged in any portion of the work associated with mitigating the incident. In like matter, the City shall not be held liable for damage to the Charter Township of Kalamazoo Fire Department equipment and the City shall fully indemnify and hold the township, its officers, board's commissions, agents and employees harmless against any and all claims, demands, law suits, actions, liability and judgments for damages arising out of this agreement. Volunteer Firefighters, do so at their own risk and under the direction and control of the Charter Township of Kalamazoo Department.
- 12. The Charter Township of Kalamazoo Fire Department will be responsible for securing all insurance information for fires it responds to.
- 13. This agreement, upon execution, will become effective on the 1st day of July, 2019, at 12:01 a.m. by and between the Charter Township of Kalamazoo (Township), and the City of Parchment (City) both in Kalamazoo County, Michigan

The purpose of this memo is to give the Kalamazoo Township board a brief history of the golf course, several issues that have come about, and three requests that have been made by the contracting company Krum-Ro, Inc. (A.K.A Jim and Ann Marie Roschek).

Krum-Ro, Inc., has operated the Grand Prairie golf course for Kalamazoo Township since 1991. This dates back to supervisor Phyllis Cleveland who originally approached the husband and wife team to operate the golf course.

The team has signed multiple renewals since the original contract each of the contracts called for a 15% return to the township on the memberships and green fees. Since the original contract, records indicate that a significant amount of money has been returned to the township. (Please see attachment A)

It is extremely important to point out that there have been several changes over the years with regards to the golf industry as a whole, and the popularity of and the number of players has increased over the years. However the number of golf courses has significantly decreased. According to the Krum- Ro, Inc. 15 years ago there were approximately 25 leagues (averaging 25 to 40 players in each league) that would use the course. The current number of leagues has declined to six (averaging 12 to 20 players in each league).

Krum- Ro Inc., has expressed concerns with regards to the equipment at the course. Earlier this year, The Township Board made arrangements for multiple pieces of equipment to be repaired and brought up to date.

Additional information that came up during our meeting. That Ann Marie, has not taken any payments from the facility in the last three years. In addition Jim, has not been paid for his labor. The last three years they have gone into their personal savings accounts to cover the shortfalls.

Krum-Ro Inc., has experienced several positive things over the years: some of them include: partnership with Western Michigan University and their utilization of the golf course, a substantial junior golf league program with over 150 junior participants in the program, Special Olympics having access to the facility on several occasions later in the season each year, also a significant number of senior citizens throughout the community who

enjoyed the facility.

Request

1. Krum -Ro Inc., request that Kalamazoo Township set aside \$10,000 per year for major repairs to be used for equipment, the facility, irrigation system and parking lot.

The management contract signed on September 19, 2013 calls for the township to invest \$7,500 per year with the improvement to remain property of Kalamazoo Township.

2. Krum- Ro Inc, has requested the return of 15% be removed from the contract.

I am in support of removing the 15% return for the last year of the current contract which expires at the end of 2019. And entering into an additional contract for a shorter period of time not to exceed 36 months without the 15% return.

3. Krum- Ro Inc., requested they receive \$10,000 a year to manage the facility.

At this time I am not in support of paying \$10,000 per year to have a management team manage the Grand Prairie course. That may be an option in the future along with exploring different opportunities and alternative methods for the property.

Conclusion

The Township Board will find attached under appendix A, a copy of the current contract for Grand Prairie golf course. Under appendix B you will find a copy of the deed to the property which would indicate the sales price along with several stipulations as to how the property can be used. Under appendix C you will find a revenue and expense report which covers a ten-year period from December 2009 through December 2018, one shown without depreciation and the second with depreciation shown. You will also have a copy of the golf course budget as approved for 2019.

The below recommendations would allow the township to come up with more conclusive wind down plans if needed to assess the effects on Township residents and its participating partners.

Recommendations

To suspend the Grand Prairie Golf 2019 15% return, and for the Manager to enter into negotiation for a new contract not to exceed 36 months (3 years) without a return fee. The final contract to be approved by the Kalamazoo Township Board.

Appendix A

Grand Prairie Golf Club Management Contract

This contract, dated Spienby 19, 2013 between the Charter Township of Kalamazoo, hereafter "TOWNSHIP," and Krum-Ro, Inc., hereafter, "CONTRACTOR," is as follows:

It Is Agreed:

I. Agreement

Commencing on the date of this contract CONTRACTOR agrees that it will operate the Grand Prairie Golf Course by the terms and conditions of this agreement. The term of this contract shall expire December 31, 2019. Notwithstanding the foregoing, either party may terminate this contract or any extension thereof upon 90 days written notice to the other, previous to such termination date. In the event the termination date is other than December 31, the lease payment due the TOWNSHIP shall be prorated to date of termination based upon a sevenmenth season of April 1 to October 20 and the number of days such contract is in effect during such period. During the term of this contract, should CONTRACTOR fail to remedy any defective performance within thirty (30) days after written notice from TOWNSHIP, then TOWNSHIP may immediately terminate this contract without further notice.

II. Services Performed by CONTRACTOR

CONTRACTOR agrees to perform the following services:

- A. Provide open golf to the general public. Also, provide league and tournament play at reasonable times. CONTRACTOR will encourage active participation by the general public.
- B. Supply and have the exclusive right to sell to the general public a full-line of golf equipment and apparel.
- C. Provide for and have exclusive right to the rental of clubs, pull-carts, and automotive carts for the general public.
- D. Have a certified P.G.A. professional on staff and have the exclusive right to provide golf instruction for individuals and groups.
- E. Have the exclusive right to provide food service arrangements based upon Health Department regulations and available clubhouse space.
- F. CONTRACTOR shall maintain the entire area within boundaries of the Grand Prairie Golf Course including clubhouse/pro shop and maintenance buildings, to a standard that is acceptable to the TOWNSHIP, and specifically indicated as follows:
 - 1. The tees, greens, fairways, roughs, and traps are to be maintained to standards generally accepted for golf course maintenance.
 - 2. The general grounds, fences, structures and golf clubhouse furnishings shall be kept neat and clean at all times.

- 3. The clubhouse and restrooms shall be kept neat and clean at all times. The maintenance buildings shall be kept in an orderly fashion.
- 4. All utilities shall be paid for by CONTRACTOR.

III. Fees, Charges and Schedules

*.

- A. The fees for open golf, leagues, and memberships and the course operating schedule must be submitted to the TOWNSHIP for approval prior to March 1 of each year.
- B. The fees and charges for concessions, rentals, instruction, etc. will be determined by CONTRACTOR but must be reasonable.
- C. Net revenue from the Granite Tee Box advertising will be shared equally with TOWNSHIP.

IV. Services and Equipment Provided by TOWNSHIP

- A. TOWNSHIP shall provide to the CONTRACTOR the equipment, small tools, and irrigation parts as listed in Exhibit "A" attached. Thereafter, CONTRACTOR will, at its own expense, provide repairs and maintenance for said equipment and also oil and gas for operations. Upon termination of this contract, CONTRACTOR shall return all equipment to TOWNSHIP in reasonably good condition.
- B. TOWNSHIP shall provide to CONTRACTOR furnished clubhouse facilities.
- C. Capital Improvements, Repairs, and Alteration: All existing improvements shall remain the property of TOWNSHIP. To insure a high level of physical maintenance of the buildings, the grounds, and the maintenance equipment, and to guard against obsolescence, CONTRACTOR will submit to TOWNSHIP various request for equipment replacement or additional equipment. It is the intent of this agreement that these capital improvements and purchases shall be paid by TOWNSHIP, if TOWNSHIP approves such a request, from the lease payment that CONTRACTOR pays to TOWNSHIP. TOWNSHIP agrees that a minimum of \$7,500.00 per year can be used for this purpose. The improvements shall remain property of TOWNSHIP.

V. Insurance

- A. TOWNSHIP will be responsible for the insurance for the buildings and grounds.
- B. CONTRACTOR shall maintain general liability insurance in the amount of not less than one million dollars (\$1,000,000.00) each occurrence. THE CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF KALAMAZOO, its employees, officials, and agents shall be named as additional insured parties. CONTRACTOR will provide TOWNSHIP with a certificate showing such insurance.
- C. CONTRACTOR shall maintain worker's compensation insurance in accordance with state law.

Vi. Entry and Inspection

TOWNSHIP shall have the right, at all reasonable times, to inspect the premises and to cause any unsatisfactory conditions relative to the operation and maintenance of the property to be corrected at CONTRACTOR's expense.

VII. Reservation of TOWNSHIP Rights

TOWNSHIP shall have the right to establish easements through the property for utilities, however, TOWNSHIP shall not unreasonably interfere with CONTRACTOR's use of the premises.

VIII. Budgetary Considerations and Payments to TOWNSHIP

CONTRACTOR shall operate, maintain, and improve the Grand Prairie Golf Club for the length of the agreement. Shortfalls will be underwritten by the CONTRACTOR. CONTRACTOR agrees to pay TOWNSHIP the sum of 15% of all revenue from green fees and memberships for the calendar years 2014 through 2019. Ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) will be paid on July 1 of each year with the balance due December 31 of each year. CONTRACTOR shall maintain a bookkeeping system for the Grand Prairie Golf Club and CONTRACTOR's records shall be accessible to TOWNSHIP at reasonable times.

IX. Independent Contractor

CONTRACTOR and its employees at all times shall be considered as independent contractors and not as TOWNSHIP employees. CONTRACTOR shall exercise all supervisory control and general control over all day-to-day operations, including control over all workers' duties, payment of all wages to CONTRACTOR's employees, and the right to hire, fire, and discipline all his/her employees. As an independent contractor, CONTRACTOR's payment under this contract shall not be subject to any withholding for tax, social security or other purposes, nor shall CONTRACTOR or his employees be entitled to sick leave, pension benefits, vacations, medical benefits, life insurance, workers or unemployment compensation, or the like.

X. Non-Assignment

CONTRACTOR shall not assign, subcontract, or otherwise transfer this contract without the prior written consent of the TOWNSHIP.
