The Board of Trustees of the *Charter Township of Kalamazoo* held a Work Group Session on Monday, May 14, 2018 at 5:30 p.m. in the Board Room of the Charter Township of Kalamazoo Administration Building, 1720 Riverview Drive, Kalamazoo, Michigan 49004-1099, for the purpose of discussing Special Meeting Agenda items, and any other business that may legally come before the Board of Trustees of the Charter Township of Kalamazoo, Kalamazoo County.

PRESENT: Supervisor Donald Martin, Clerk Mark Miller, Treasurer Sherine Miller, Trustees

Jeremy Hathcock, Nicolette Leigh, and Steven Leuty. Trustee Jennifer Strebs

joined the meeting at 5:40 p.m.

ABSENT:

ALSO PRESENT: Township Manager Dexter Mitchell.

Supervisor Martin called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m. A number of Planning Commission and Zoning Board of Appeals members were present in the audience.

<u>Item 1</u> – <u>CLIMATE CHANGE PRESENTATION BY DR. DAVID KAROWE, WMU</u> Dr. Karowe was not present.

<u>Item 2</u> – <u>PRESENTATION ON ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT BY SOUTHWEST</u> MICHIGAN FIRST

Jill Bland, managing partner presented along with Derek Nofz. Mr. Nofz spoke about training opportunities to promote economic development. Internships count as being in school for per-pupil school funding. Ms. Bland stated that the goal is to provide jobs and shared prosperity. The focus is on small business and primary employers (selling to customers beyond the region). Southwest Michigan First (SWMF) will work with businesses to identify needs they have to expand. 70% of growth will come from existing primary employers.

SWMF will work with site decision makers to highlight advantages of Southwest Michigan. Decision makers will look at demographics, size, labor pool, talent, incentives, speed of permitting process, and operating costs. They run a program on how to do internships and apprenticeships.

Examples of successes are Summit Polymers, Target Distribution Center, and One Way Products. A number of potential sites in Kalamazoo Township and elsewhere were discussed.

Item 3 – MTA CONFERENCE REPORTS

Trustee Leuty spoke about the inspiring talk by MTA Director Larry Merrill. He found the presentations on leading effective land use meetings, wind siting, and website development valuable, as well as the MERS speaker on pension plan options and individualized health benefit plans.

Trustee Leigh spoke about problems with wind turbines, and the fact that solar energy is easier to control. The social media program showed that this area is in flux.

Manager Mitchell loved the social media presentation, and the talk on 425 agreements.

Treasurer Miller appreciated the "Greater Township, Greater Good" slogan of the MTA Conference, and sees this as a summary of all our efforts.

Clerk Miller reported on the half-day session on Cemetery Management, and suggested we may need a Cemetery Ordinance.

Supervisor Martin thanked the Planning Commission.

Clerk Miller left the meeting at 6:25 p.m.

Item 4 - MANAGER'S 2018 GOALS

Manager Mitchell presented a PowerPoint showing his goals for 2018, including those from the Township Strategic Plan. He asked the Board for comments or suggestions.

<u>Item 5</u> – <u>STATUS OF QUALITY PRECAST MOVE</u>

Quality Precast is in the process of obtaining an occupancy permit for their new site in Alamo Township. It is projected that they will move from their Kalamazoo Township site in June or July.

<u>Item 6 – DISCUSSION REGARDING ITEMS ON THE REGULAR AGENDA</u>

Item 7 – PUBLIC COMMENT

Jim Cripps, Planning Commission member, commented on the cost of re-developing brownfields.

Diane Sower, 3826 N Westnedge, commented on the connection between the US Business Route 131 interchange and economic development.

Item 1 CALL TO ORDER

Supervisor Martin called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m.

<u>Item 2</u> <u>PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE</u>

Trustee Strebs led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Trustee Hathcock moved, seconded by Trustee Leigh, to excuse Clerk Miler from the May 14, 2018, Regular Board of Trustees Meeting. Motion carried.

Trustee Leigh moved, seconded by Trustee Strebs, to remove Item B (Minutes of April 9, 2018 Work Session Meeting) from the Consent Agenda; and move to Item 10 of the Regular Agenda. Motion carried.

Item 5 PUBLIC COMMENT ON AGENDA AND NON-AGENDA ITEMS

Robert Pane??, 5331 Colony Woods, shared that a group of young people are interested in volunteering to help with removal of evasive plants, planting of new wildflowers, and basic maintenance. He also asked that the Township consider adding benches and a designated handicap parking space to Sheid Park

The Khillah's, 2104 Kenwood Street, shared concerns with burning trash at 613 Campbell, as well as a fallen branch near the corner of Kenwood Street and Campbell Avenue.

Mike Schwartz, Engineer for Prein & Newhoff, updated the Board on the status of the Stormwater Asset Management and Wastewater (SAW) Grant.

Kate VerBrugge, 616 Stassen Avenue, addressed concerns with Quality Precast and industrial zoning.

Item 9 NEW BUSINESS

Item 9A REQUEST TO ADOPT OUTDOOR BURNING ORDINANCE NO. 597

The proposed Outdoor Burning Ordinance's purpose is to protect the health and safety of the people and property from fire hazards caused by recreational and cooking fires, and prohibit all other types of outdoor burning.

Trustee Leigh moved, seconded by Supervisor Martin, to adopt the Outdoor Burning Ordinance; effective thirty (30) days following publication. Roll call vote: 4 – yes, 2 – no (Trustee Hathcock, Treasurer Miller), 1 – absent (Clerk Miller). Motion carried.

Item 9B REQUEST TO ADOPT FIRE STANDARDS REVIEW ORDINANCE FOR FIRST READING

The Fire Standards Review Ordinance will establish standards for site plan review as established by NFPA – 1 and the current Township Fire Code into a cohesive ordinance. The "Fire Department Site Plan Review" means consideration of certain physical aspects of new, refurbished, and existing commercial and multi-unit residential sites for compliance with the standards set forth in this Ordinance and the current Township Fire Code by the Township Fire Marshal in order to ensure the health, safety and welfare of occupants and surrounding property owners.

Treasurer Miller moved, seconded by Trustee Hathcock, to accept the Charter Township of Kalamazoo Fire Review Standards Ordinance for first reading. Motion carried.

Item 9C REQUEST TO ADOPT TEMPORARY TENT PERMIT ORDINANCE FOR FIRST READING

The proposed Kalamazoo Charter Township Portable Structure Ordinance will define and regulate the placement of temporary structures including tents, air-inflated structures and membrane-covered structures.

Fire Marshal Kowalski addressed the Board's questions, including clarification of not-for-profit.

It was also suggested to amend and make consistent the name and purpose of the ordinance, and call it the Kalamazoo Charter Township Portable Structure Ordinance. .

Trustee Leigh moved, seconded by Treasurer Miller, to accept the Kalamazoo Charter Township Portable Structure Ordinance for first reading, as amended. Motion carried.

Item 9D REQUEST TO ADOPT MOBILE FOOD TRUCKS AND TRAILERS FIRE SAFETY REQUIREMENTS ORDINANCE FOR FIRST READING

The proposed Mobile Food Trucks and Trailer Fire Safety Requirements Ordinance will require mobile food trucks and trailers used within the Charter Township of Kalamazoo to meet certain minimum standards for general safety, fuel and power sources, as well as address operational and propane system safety.

It was asked about the 10 ft distance between vehicles, and Fire Marshal Kowalski explained the necessity of the 10 ft requirement.

Supervisor Martin moved, seconded by Trustee Hathcock, to accept the Kalamazoo Charter Township Mobile food Trucks and Trailer Fire Safety Requirements Ordinance for first reading. Motion carried.

Item 9E REQUEST TO SUPPORT POLICE DEPARTMENT PAR PLAN GRANT APPLICATION FOR ACQUIRING SECURE STORAGE CABINETS

The Township of Kalamazoo Police Department (TKPD) is requesting to apply for a \$5,000 grant and for an estimated amount of \$3,127.48 covered by the Township of Kalamazoo for the purchase of and installation of storage cabinets and shelving to reorganize existing space and install secure storage within the department.

Trustee Strebs moved, seconded by Trustee Leuty, to approve and support the grant application in the amount of \$5,000 to the Michigan Township Participating Plan Risk Reduction Grant Program for the safety and security of equipment at the Township of Kalamazoo Police Department (TKPD); and to approve the TKPD to cover additional costs in acquiring equipment to complete the purchase of equipment upon receipt of the grant. Roll call vote: 6 – yes, 0 – no, 1 – absent (Clerk Miller). Motion carried.

Item 9F REQUEST FOR AUTHORIZATION TO PURCHASE FOUR POLICE DEPARTMENT PATROL VEHICLES

Supervisor Martin moved, seconded by Trustee Leigh, to approve the purchase of four (4) Ford Interceptor Utility police patrol vehicles from Signature Ford in the amount of \$130,132; and authorize the Township Manager to sign on behalf of the Township of Kalamazoo. Motion carried.

Item 9G REQUEST FOR AUTHORIZATION TO HAVE AUTOMATIC DOOR OPENERS INSTALLED

In an effort to be compliant with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) and to enhance the safety and quality of life for our employees and visitors, it is recommended to improve the accessibility of the Township by installing automatic door openers using the existing doors and entrance layouts.

Trustee Strebs moved, seconded by Trustee Hathcock, to authorize the Township Supervisor to sign the proposal acceptance memo and any additional paperwork needed to complete the project as proposed by Automatic Equipment Sales & Service of Comstock Park, Michigan, for the total cost of \$8,202. Motion carried.

Item 9H REQUEST TO AUTHORIZE THE REPAIR OF TENNIS COURTS AT STROUD FAMILY PARK

Supervisor Martin moved, seconded by Trustee Leigh, to authorize the Township Manager to approve the proposal submitted by Asphalt Solutions Plus to repair cracks in the surface of two tennis courts at Stroud Family Park at a cost of \$2,100. Motion carried.

Item 9I REQUEST TO AUTHORIZE REPAIR AND RESURFACING OF THE TOWNSHIP PARKING LOT

Supervisor Martin moved, seconded by Treasurer Miller, to authorize the Township Supervisor to sign the proposal acceptance memo and any additional paperwork needed to complete the project as proposed by the J. Allen & Company of Galesburg, Michigan, not to accede \$80,000. Motion carried.

Item 9J REQUEST TO RECOMMEND PINE GROVE TOWNSHIP BE ACCEPTED INTO KALAMAZOO AREA BUILDING AUTHORITY

Treasurer Miller moved, seconded by Supervisor Martin, to approve the Resolution authorizing Pine Grove Township to join the Kalamazoo Area Building Authority (KABA). Roll call vote: 6 – yes, 0 – no, 1 – absent (Clerk Miller). Resolution adopted.

<u>Item 10A</u> <u>APPROVAL OF MINUTES OF THE APRIL 9, 2018 BOARD OF TRUSTEES</u> WORK SESSION MEETING

Trustee Leigh asked to remove Item B (Approval of Minutes of April 9, 2018 Work Session Minutes) from the Consent Agenda due to Item 3 (Discussion of Non-Union Municipal Employees' Retirement System (MERS) Pension Plan) of the April 9, 2018 Board of Trustees Work Session minutes.

After a brief discussion, it was decided to table the consent agenda item until further conversation with Clerk Miller.

Item 11 COMMITTEE REPORTS

Treasurer Miller updated the Board on the Kalamazoo Area Building Authority (KABA).

Trustee Hathcock reported on the May 3, 2018 Planning Commission meeting. Items included a special use permit for a medical marijuana provisioning center located at 1986 Sprinkle Road, the expansion site plan review for Aldi's, 3720 Gull Road, and discussion of the meaning of "retail" in the RM-2 District. The next Planning Commission meeting will be on June 7, 2018 at the Kalamazoo Township Hall.

Trustee Leigh shared that Metro Connect will have seven new replacement vans. She also noted that Community Action Agency (CAA) will be moving July 30 – August 3 to a new location on Alcott Street, the Department of Human Service building.

Trustee Leuty updated the Board on Kalamazoo Township Parks and thanked Chief Obreiter and the Maintenance Department for creating a concrete pad for a bench at Rynbrandt Park.

Supervisor Martin reported that the new generators are in place for Stations 1 and 4, and that the Township will be selling the old generators.

Manager Mitchell reported on the Kalamazoo Area Transportation Study (KATS) meeting and shared that the Road Commission of Kalamazoo County (RCKC) will be utilizing ground rubber tire as part of a road mix.

Item 12 ATTORNEY'S REPORT

There was no Township Attorney's report.

Item 12A MANAGER REPORT

Manager Mitchell encouraged everyone to sign up for Smart 911, and reported that the Township is still working with Gryphon Place and 211 for flood assistance and moving from a reactive plan to a proactive plan. He also shared that the Township will be hosting a Blood Drive on May 17, 2018 at the Township Hall. Lastly, Mr. Mitchell recently attended the Citizens Police Academy and strongly encouraged board members and staff to attend. The Academy educates citizens on fire and law enforcement and allows them to experience a realistic view and insight of the Departments. It also consists of demonstrations, videos, lectures, and slideshow presentations.

<u>Item 13</u> <u>PUBLIC COMMENTS</u>

Ron Huster, 1314 Coolidge, thanked the Board for passing the outdoor burning Ordinance No. 597, and would like to have a member of the Kalamazoo Township Fire Department address a Westwood Neighborhood Association meeting and to provide contact information. He also thanked the Board for approving repairs to the tennis courts.

Dr. Latif Khillah, 2104 Kenwood, asked about the cost of ADA eligible rides through Metro Connect. Mrs. Khillah also shared concern with conditions of a sidewalk on Campbell Avenue.

<u>Item 14</u> <u>BOARD MEMBER COMMENTS</u>

Trustee Strebs updated the Board on the Kalamazoo County ID Project and encouraged everyone to help the community and support the program by obtaining the ID. The program was launched to help people in the community who have trouble accessing photo identification from the State. She also attended and commented on a health policy forum hosted at Michigan State University, and shared that she looks forward to the upcoming 77th Annual Westwood Ice Cream Social on July 27, 2018.

Trustee Hathcock shared that the Eastwood Community Garden will have its grand opening on May 26, 2018. He recognized Christopher Mihelich, Manager Mitchell, Carolyn Kennedy, and Ernest Spencer for their help.

Trustee Leigh commented on the education that is available to the Board Members and how elected officials have the opportunity to learn and incorporate it into the Township.

Treasurer Miller commented on the Disability Network Quarterly Newsletter. She highlighted the upcoming senior millage on August 7, 2018 and the youth training transition for education to employment in this issue.

Trustee Leuty shared that National Emergency Medical Service (EMS) week honoring EMS and all emergency responders for their dedicated service is May 20th – May 26th, 2018. He also recognized Trustee Strebs who was recently honored with Bronson's President's Team Award for her work with Bronson's Patient and Family Advisory Council. Lastly, Mr. Leuty shared the history, the master plan and the emphasis on keeping Sheid Park as a natural area.

Supervisor Martin thanked everyone for attending the Board Meeting.

APPLICATION TO CONSTRUCT, OPERATE, USE AND/OR MAINTAIN WITHIN THE RIGHT-OF-WAY, OR TO CLOSE, A COUNTY ROAD

An applicant is defined as an owner of property adjacent to the right-of-way, the property owner's authorized representative; or an authorized representative of a private or public utility who applies for a permit to construct, operate, use, and/or maintain a facility within the right-of-way for the purpose outlined within the application. A contractor who makes application on behalf of a property owner or utility must provide documentation of authority to apply for a permit. When applicant hires a contractor, the permittee is the applicant and the contractor.



<u>Item 1 – DISCUSSION OF ROAD COMMISSION OF KALAMAZOO COUNTY (RCKC)</u> <u>SIDEWALK AND NON-MOTORIZED AGREEMENTS</u>

Ryan Minkus from the Road Commission of Kalamazoo County (RCKC) explained that the desire was to have an umbrella agreement so that the Board would not need to have a separate meeting for each contract.

Trustee Leigh asked if the Township is paying for most of the project and why we need to put up 90%. It was explained that was standard practice of the Road Commission. The Road Commission must agree with the State that the money above the granted amount would be coming.

<u>Item 2 – DISCUSSION OF PROPOSED OUTDOOR BURN ORDINANCE</u>

Fire Marshal Todd Kowalski explained the intention behind the ordinance.

Clerk Miller asked about the reason burning of leaves was not explicitly forbidden.

Attorney Roxanne Seeber drafted a new Definition 4: "Prohibited fires" and a new section, "Regulations: Prohibited fires shall not be permitted in the Township."

Trustee Leuty pointed out that many assist calls are for 'trouble breathing'.

Item 3 - DISCUSSION OF NON-UNION MERS PENSION PLAN

Manager Mitchell explained the proposal to move to the Municipal Employees' Retirement System (MERS) defined-benefit plan for non-union employees. At 2.0 multiplier, the Township would save \$60,000 per year, or 2.5 would save \$21,000. This would set a cap of 10% of salary into pension plan as the Township's obligation.

It was suggested that Firefighters might wish to opt out of Social Security in order to maximize MERS benefits.

We are currently 109% funded.

<u>Item 4 – DISCUSSION REGARDING ITEMS ON THE REGULAR AGENDA</u> There was no discussion on regular agenda items.

KALAMAZOO CHARTER TOWNSHIP KALAMAZOO COUNTY, MICHIGAN ORDINANCE NO. 598

ADOPTED: MAY 29, 2018

EFFECTIVE:	

An ordinance to protect the public health, safety and welfare by establishing standards for site plan review by the Township Fire Marshal; specifying the types and locations of Knox Boxes and Fire Department Connections; requiring standards for hazardous materials storage; addressing fire hydrant locations; and providing minimum standards for turning radii, drive aisles, safety bollards, and parking areas; to provide an effective date; and to repeal all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict therewith.

THE CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF KALAMAZOO, KALAMAZOO COUNTY, MICHIGAN

ORDAINS:

SECTION 1 NAME AND PURPOSE

This Ordinance shall be known and cited as the Charter Township of Kalamazoo Fire Review Standards Ordinance. The purpose of the ordinance is to collect those standards for site plan review by the fire marshal as established by NFPA -1 and the current Township Fire Code into a cohesive ordinance; to require adherence to such standards by applicants for fire department review; and to provide for an effective date.

SECTION 2 APPLICABILITY OF ORDINANCE

"Fire Department Site Plan Review" means consideration of certain physical aspects of new, refurbished, and existing commercial and multi-unit residential sites for compliance with the standards set forth in this Ordinance and the current Township Fire Code by the Township Fire Marshal in order to ensure the health, safety and welfare of occupants and surrounding property owners. Upon a determination of compliance with site plan review standards contained herein, the fire marshal shall provide certification of compliance to the Township Building Official, who may utilize it in consideration of the granting of an occupancy permit. No occupancy permit shall be granted by the building official without certification of adherence to the standards contained in this ordinance or modification of the same as established by the Township Fire Marshal.

The Township Fire Marshal shall be permitted to implement field adjustments as needed during inspection. Field adjustments shall be noted on the approved plan.

SECTION 3 STANDARDS FOR FIRE DEPARTMENT SITE PLAN REVIEW

An applicant for fire department site plan review by the Township's Fire Marshal shall establish that the following standards are met:

- A. *Knox Boxes*. Knox Boxes are required and shall meet and be installed in accordance with the standards contained in this section. Knox Box devices shall only be purchased at www.knoxbox.com.
 - A Knox Box of size "3200" series or larger shall be provided on the exterior of the building. The Knox Box vault shall be mounted, unobstructed and visible approximately five feet from ground level near a main access door.
 - 2. A Knox elevator key box shall be installed adjacent to any elevator.
 - 3. Externally-mounted Knox power shut off switches may be required by the Fire Marshal upon review.
- B. Storage of Chemicals and Hazardous Materials. An applicant wishing to store chemicals or hazardous materials on site shall designate the proposed location for the same and must establish adherence to the following standards:
 - 1. The storage and use of chemicals on site shall have all SDS information visible and the applicant shall submit a "Right to Know" survey.
 - 2. An Architect or Engineer shall review and identify the hazard class of the site and/or the structure.
 - The Maximum Allowable Quantities of regulated material shall be submitted as well as a detailed plan indicating how the requirements for each control area are intended to be met. A maximum of four control areas are allowed.

C. Fire Hydrants.

- 1. Fire Hydrant placement shall be approved by the Fire Marshal. Fire Hydrants shall be installed in the approved location only.
- 2. Fire Hydrants which are not publicly owned will not be considered for use during site plan review.
- 3. Public/Private Fire Hydrants shall be identified by signage approved by the City of Kalamazoo (water service provider).

- 4. Public and Private fire hydrants shall be supplied by a water main of not less than six inches in diameter.
- 5. Fire hydrants shall be located not more than 300 feet from the site.
- 6. Fire hydrant spacing shall not exceed 300 feet from each hydrant.
- 7. Water mains serving fire suppression systems shall not be less than six inches in diameter. The water main size may be reduced upon submittal of engineered/architectural stamped and sealed fire suppression plans in detail including calculations to the Fire Marshal and water service provider. Plans shall be approved the city of Kalamazoo Water Department (water service provider).
- 8. After landscaping, the discharge ports for fire hydrants shall be 24" from the ground measured from the bottom of the lowest port to the ground

D. Fire Department Connections (FDC)

- 1. The Fire Department connections (FDC) shall have Knox 2.5" Locking FDC Plugs with swivel guard or 5" locking cap, whichever is applicable.
- 2. The FDC shall be located within 100 feet of a fire hydrant.
- 3. The FDC may be remotely located away from the building.
- 4. The FDC location shall be identified and approved by the Fire Marshal during fire department site plan review.
- Immediate access to the FDC shall be maintained in clear view without obstructions by fences, bushes, trees, walls, dumpsters or any other object.
- 6. The FDC shall be so located so that fire apparatus and hydrant lines connect to supply the system will not obstruct access to the buildings for other fire apparatus.
- 7. FDC shall not be obstructed by parking spaces; marked or unmarked.
- 8. FDCs not remotely located shall be fully visible and recognizable from the street.
- 9. The FDC shall be identifiable to all approaching fire apparatus.
- 10. The FDCs shall be indicated by an approved sign mounted on the street, front, side of the building or adjacent to a remotely located FDC.
- 11. FDC signage shall contain the letters "FDC" of at least 6 inches in height.
- 12.FDC Signage shall be reflective with white letters on a red background. All such signs shall be subject to approval by the fire marshal.

- 13. FDC shall have an exterior rated strobe and horn device above the FDC, approximately eight to ten feet in height. The device shall be located in clear view to approaching fire apparatus.
- E. *Protective Bollards*. Protective bollards shall be provided in the locations specified in this section and shall meet the standards of this section.
 - Protective Bollards shall be required to protect egress doors or pathways where vehicles or other devices (dumpsters, shopping carts, outside displays etc) can be parked or placed which could impede the pathway or door motion from a required egress door
 - 2. Protective Bollards shall be installed protecting any exposed electric or gas device, connection, piping, meter, FDC, fire hydrant, fire stand pipe connection, LP Storage tank, LP transfer point, LP point of sale.
 - 3. Protective bollards shall also be erected at any point where a vehicle will be driving alongside or up to the building such as that of a drivethru sales window.
 - 4. Protective bollards shall be placed regardless of whether a sidewalk is placed between the device and the area for parking. Bollards shall be constructed to the minimum standard detailed in the current Kalamazoo Township Fire Code.
- F. Building Identification. All applicants for fire department site plan review shall provide building identification in accordance with the standards of this section of the Ordinance.
 - 1. Building Identification shall be placed in a position that is plainly legible and visible from any street or road fronting the property.
 - 2. Those properties fronting more than one street or road shall contain address identification consisting of both number and street name.
 - 3. The address number and street names shall contrast with the background color of the identification sign.
 - 4. Address numbers on commercial and industrial building identification signs shall be at least 10 inches in height.
 - 5. Addresses letters indicating street names shall be 10" to 24", height of lettering to be approved during fire department site plan review.
- G. Fire Access Lanes, Parking Lots, and Access Roads. Applications for fire department site plan review shall establish compliance with the fire access lanes, parking lot and access road requirements of this section of the Ordinance.

- 1. Parking lots, driveways, and service and access drives shall be designed and constructed to allow turning and full operation of full-sized fire apparatus during an emergency.
- 2. Dead-end access roads and parking lots in excess of 150 feet in length shall be provided with approved provisions for the fire apparatus to turn around.
- 3. Overhangs or other portions of the structure intended to be driven under shall be approved by the fire marshal's office. Engineering specifications and design shall be provided by the applicant.
- 4. Security gates restricting access shall be approved pursuant to the requirements of the current Kalamazoo Charter Township Fire Code. Approved fences, gates or other barriers shall be accessed through Knox padlocks, Knox access switches and siren activation.

SEVERABILITY

Should any section, clause or provision of this Ordinance be declared unconstitutional, illegal or of no force and effect by a court of competent jurisdiction, then and in that event such portion thereof shall not be deemed to affect the validity of any other part or portion of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4 REPEAL

Conflicting Ordinance provisions are hereby repealed. The Kalamazoo Charter Township Fire Code is deemed to be consistent with the provisions of this ordinance and therefore no portion of the same is repealed by adoption of this ordinance.

SECTION 5 EFFECTIVE DATE

This Ordinance shall take effect the day after publication of a summary hereof, after adoption, as required by law.

CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF KALAMAZOO ORDINANCE NO. 599

ADOPTED: MAY 29, 2018

EFFECTIVE:	
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PORTABLE STRUCTURE ORDINANCE

An ordinance to define and regulate the placement of portable structures including tents, air-inflated structures and membrane-covered structures; to provide for a fire-watch in some situations; to require a site plan; to require a permit for the placement of such tent; portable structure; to provide an effective date; to provide standards for tents, canvas/membrane and air-inflated structures; and to repeal all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict therewith.

The Charter Township of Kalamazoo ordains:

Section 1 Name and Purpose

This Ordinance shall be known and cited as the "Kalamazoo Charter Township Portable Structure Ordinance". The purpose of the Ordinance is to define and regulate the placement of portable structures including tents, air-inflated structures and membrane-covered structures; to provide for a fire watch in some situations; to provide standards for such structures; to require a site plan; and to require a permit for the use and placement of such tent(s).

Section 2 Definitions

For purposes of this Ordinance, the following words and phrases shall be defined as indicated:

- A. Tent A structure, enclosure or shelter with sidewalls constructed of fabric or pliable material supported by any manner except by air or the contents that it protects.
- B. Canopy A structure, enclosure or shelter constructed of fabric or pliable material supported by any manner except by air or the contents it protects, and is open without sidewalls or drops on 75 percent or more of the perimeter.
- C. Air-inflated structure A structure that uses air-pressurized beams, arches or other elements to enclose space. Occupants of such a structure do not occupy the pressurized area used to support the structure.
- D. Membrane-Covered Cable Structure A non-pressurized structure in which a mast and cable system provides support and tension to the membrane weather barrier and the membrane imparts structural stability to the structure.

- E. Membrane-covered Frame Structure A non-pressurized building wherein the structure is composed of a rigid framework to support a tensioned membrane which provides the weather barrier.
- F. AHJ The Charter Township of Kalamazoo, Kalamazoo County, Michigan.
- G. NFPA-1 National Fire Protection Association-1 entitled the "Uniform Fire Code" including any additions, corrections or changes in currently in effect for the Charter Township of Kalamazoo.
- H. SCC- the Michigan Single-State Construction Code as administered and enforced by the Charter Township of Kalamazoo.
- I. Concession stand is a structure from which food is prepared, served and sold on a temporary or seasonal basis, which is not a food truck. A concession stand may be part of a fair, ball park, or recreational facility but does not include a school sale, bake sale or other event at which packaged or pre-cooked food is brought to the stand to be sold.
- J. Portable structure any type of structure identified in A E of this Section.

Section 3 Permit Required

- A. <u>Permit Required.</u> Prior to the erection, use, placement, or operation of any of the following portable structures as defined herein, the owner or operator of the land on which the portable structure is to be located shall apply for a "portable structure permit" from the Charter Township of Kalamazoo Fire Chief or Fire Marshal or a designee. A portable structure permit shall be required for:
 - 1. Any air-supported portable membrane structure or tent having an area of in excess of 200 square feet.
 - 2. A canopy in excess of 400 square feet.
 - 3. All tents regardless of size that affect or are a part of the means of egress from any building.
 - 4. Portable structure permits are required for all picnics/carnivals on Townshipowned property or any public right-of-way in addition to the above requirements
- **B.** Exception to permit requirement. The following portable structures shall not require a permit prior to the erection or operation thereof:
 - 1. A structure identified in Section 3A. herein that is used for the purpose of camping (NFPA 1:1.12.8(a)).
 - 2. Tents smaller than 1,000 square feet, or for private family events on the same lot with the residence.
 - 3. A picnic/carnival operated 2-1/2 days or less by a not-for-profit organization, and operated on private ground owned by and adjacent to said organization's facilities, requires no portable structure permit(s) (except adherence to the electrical standards under Section 5Q herein shall be required).

- C. <u>Submittal requirements for Portable Structure Permit.</u> All applicants for a portable structure permit shall provide the following to the Charter Township of Kalamazoo Fire Department at least 30 days prior to the date intended for erection or operation thereof:
 - 1. A site plan meeting the requirements of Section 4 of this Ordinance.
 - **2.** A notarized letter from the property owner giving permission to put the tent on the property.
 - **3.** A permit fee in an amount as shall be determined from time-to-time by resolution of the Township Board.
- **D.** <u>Validity and time frame</u>. Portable structure permit(s) shall not be valid for more than 90 days in any 365-day period.
- **E.** <u>Authority of Fire Marshal.</u> The Fire Marshal shall be permitted to revoke or suspend a permit or approval issued if any violation of this Ordinance is found upon inspection or in case any false statements or misrepresentations have been submitted in the application or plans on which the permit or approval was based. (NFPA 1:1.12.7.1).
- F. <u>Issuance of Permit.</u> The Kalamazoo Charter Township Fire Department shall review the submittal and permit request and shall utilize the regulations and site plan parameters outlined herein to review the request as to whether it meets the standards required of this Ordinance. If changes or revisions are necessary, the AHJ shall notify the requestor that items are missing, needed or require changing within 72 hours of determination by the AHJ. Upon receipt of an application and review and approval of documentation contained therein, the AHJ shall issue a Portable Structure Permit which shall indicate the township's approval for the structure(s) and event(s) and shall contain the dates and times of the event and a signature of the approving official.

SECTION 4 SITE PLAN REQUIRED

All applicants for a portable structure permit shall submit a site plan or sketch plan acceptable to the AHJ which shall, at a minimum, provide the following:

- A. Provide a north arrow and show all permanent structures on the site, parcel or lot and their dimensions.
- B. Show the proposed location of the portable structure, its dimensions and its relationship to the permanent buildings and other portable structures, if applicable.
- C. The location of all property lines.
- D. Proposed location of all ingress/egress; temporary lighting; tent stakes; and generators, which shall be in compliance with the regulations contained in Section 5 of this Ordinance.
- E. Proposed location of all compressed gas tanks.

- F. A Scaled Plan with the scale indicated (USE 1/4" OR 1/8" SCALE) indicating size and location of the portable structure including all objects located or to be located within 20 feet of the portable structure.
- G. A Detailed Scope of Work/Event Plan/Brief Narrative describing the event.
- H. Dates and times of the event.
- I. Location of the event.
- J. The estimated number of attendees.
- K. Indicate the location of generators.
- L. Provide a floor plan of tables, chairs, stage (s), bars or counters, if any.
- M. Demonstrate/Depict Fire Department Access Routes on Plan (NFPA 1:18.1.3.1).
- N. Demonstrate/Depict Fire Hydrant locations on Plan (NFPA 1:18.1.3.2).
- O. All carnival rides shall provide a portable fire extinguisher with a minimum 2A10BC rating.
- P. Indicate the location of toilet facilities and the fixture count.
- Q. Provide operations plan for occupant load control, emergency exiting and security.
- R. Provide certificate of flame resistance for each portable structure.

SECTION 5 REGULATIONS APPLICABLE TO ALL PORTABLE STRUCTURES

The following regulations are applicable to all portable structures, regardless of whether a permit has been obtained or is required:

- A. No portable structure shall be permitted to remain on any part or parcel of land or a site for more than 90 days in any 365-day period unless a waiver has been granted by the AHJ.
- B. Exit and emergency lighting shall be required.
- C. All portable structures shall be located not less than 5 feet from property lines.
- D. All portable structures shall be supported and anchored to withstand a wind speed of 90 miles per hour (MPH).
- E. Stake lines, if utilized, shall be a minimum of 10 feet (120 inches) apart from all other stake lines and supports.
- F. Adjacent portable structures shall be spaced to provide an area to be used as a means of emergency egress. Where the 10-foot (120 inches) separation distance between stakes lines does not meet the means of egress required herein, the distance necessary for a means of egress shall govern.
- G. Generators and other internal combustion power sources shall be located a minimum of 20 feet from portable structures and shall be protected from public contact by fencing, barricades, etc.
- H. Combustible decorative material is strictly prohibited. Floor service and area surrounding the exterior of the portable structure up to 30 feet shall be free of combustible material that may present a fire hazard.
- I. All portable structures shall have posted in a conspicuous place thereon a certificate of the flame resistance of the tent fabric material which shall include the name(s) and address(es) of the owner(s) of the structure, the date the fabric was last treated

- with flame resistant solution, the trade name or type of chemical used in treatment, the name of person or firm treating the material, and name of testing agency and test standard by which the fabric was tested (NFPA 1:25 2.2.)
- J. All stages and canopy areas are required to have a tagged certified (commercial grade) portable fire extinguisher in plain view and proper signage identifying that the extinguisher is present at the location.
- K. Smoking shall not be permitted in any portable structure. (NFPA 1:25 2.4.2.1)
- L. Compressed gas tanks such a helium tanks used for filling balloons need to be in a stand or secured in a manner, so the tank does not fall over.
- M. The AHJ shall be permitted to regulate all outdoor events such as carnivals and fairs as it pertains to access for emergency vehicles; to fire protection equipment; placement of stands, concession booths, and exhibits; and the control of hazardous conditions dangerous to life and property (NFPA 1:10.14.2).
- N. Open flames or other devices emitting flame, fire or heat, or any flammable or combustible liquids, gas, charcoal or other cooking device or any other unapproved devices shall not be permitted inside or located within 20 feet of the tent or membrane structures while open to the public unless approved by the Fire Marshal or his/her designee.
- O. Fire Protection Equipment to be provided. All portable structures shall provide fire protection equipment as follows:
 - Portable dry chemical fire extinguishers with a minimum 2A-10BC rating shall be provided so that travel distance does not exceed 75 from any point to an extinguisher.
 - 2) Extinguishers shall have updated inspection tags (inspected annually), and shall be mounted on approved hangers. The hanging of extinguishers utilizing zip ties etc. is not acceptable.
 - 3) Certain use conditions (fireworks sales, etc.) may require pressurized water extinguishers in addition to the dry chemical type.
- P. Means of egress signing and regulations. All portable structures shall adhere to the following parameters as to means of egress:
 - 1) Exits shall be spaced at equal intervals as can be best accomplished.
 - 2) Any interior areas of the portable structure shall be located within 100 feet of an exit.
 - 3) Curtains over exit openings shall be of a color or colors that contrast the adjoining tent color, and curtains shall be on sliding metal supports, located a minimum of 80 inches above the floor surface. Curtains may be taped along edges with colored tape to achieve the contrast requirements stated above, if approved by the Fire Marshal or his/her designee.
 - 4) Exit doors, if required, shall open in the direction of travel.
 - 5) Exit signs shall be clearly posted at each exit for tents serving an Occupancy Load ("OL") of 50 persons or more. Exit signs shall be either listed and labeled in accordance with UL 924 as the "internally illuminated" type, or externally illuminated in accordance with the following:
 - a) For Occupancy Load of 300 or less, two separate circuits, one of which is separate from all other circuits; or

- b) For Occupancy Load of more than 300, two sources of power, one of which is an "emergency system" supplied by batteries or on-site generators, for a minimum of 90 minutes duration.
- 6) The required number and minimum width of exits shall be in accordance with the following:
- 7) Occupant load (OL) 10 to 199: Minimum 2 exits, minimum 72 inches per exit.
 - a) OL 200 to 499: Minimum 3 exits, 72 inches per exit.
 - b) OL 500 to 999: Minimum 4 exits, 96 inches per exit.
 - c) OL 1,000 to 1,999: Minimum 5 exits, 120 inches per exit.
 - d) OL 2,000 to 2,999: Minimum 6 exits, 120 inches per exit.
 - e) Over 3,000: Minimum 7 exits, 120 inches per exit
- 8) All means of egress shall be illuminated at floor level during all times the tent is occupied. In most cases, the general lighting already available will satisfy this requirement.
- 9) No guy wire or guy rope shall cross any means of egress at a height of less than 7 feet. (NFPA 1: 25.1.3.2).
- 10) Tent stakes adjacent to any means of egress from any tent open to the public railed off, capped or covered as not to present a hazard to the public. (NFPA 1: 25.1.3.3).
- Q. Electrical regulations. All portable structures in which electrical components are used or added shall adhere to the following electrical regulations:
 - 1) Extension cords shall be free from splices, damages, or deterioration. (NFPA 1:11.1.5.3).
 - 2) Extension cords shall have the proper amp capacity that is not less than the capacity of the appliance. Indoor extension cords may not be used for exterior use (NFPA 1:11.1.5.2).
 - 3) Extension cords shall be grounded when serving grounded portable appliances. (NFPA 1:11.1.5.4).
 - 4) The electrical system and equipment shall be isolated from the public by proper elevation or guarding, and all electrical fuses and switches shall be enclosed in approved enclosures. Cables on the ground in areas traversed by the public shall be placed in trenches or protected by approved covers (NFPA 1:25.1.9.3).
 - 5) All generators must be properly electrically grounded with a grounding rod if the actual frame of the generator is not contacting the earth.
 - 6) Generators and any other internal combustion power source shall be separated from portable membrane structures and tents by a minimum of 5 feet and shall be protected from contact by fencing, enclosure or other approved means. (NFPA 1:25.1.12.1).
 - 7) Fuel tanks shall be of adequate capacity to permit uninterrupted operation during normal operating hours. Refueling shall be conducted only when not in use. (NFPA 1:25.1.12.2).
 - 8) Fuel being used in the generators must be stored in proper fuel containers and properly sealed with appropriate spout covers, caps, etc.

9) A fire extinguisher (minimum 2A10BC in size) shall provide with the use of a generator. (NFPA 1:25.1.12.3)

SECTION 6 REGULATIONS FOR AIR-INFLATED STRUCTURES

Air-inflated structures as defined by this ordinance shall adhere to the following standards and are subject to the following regulations:

A. Inflation systems.

- 1. <u>Primary inflation system and auxiliary inflation system:</u> All air-inflated structures shall be provided with a primary and auxiliary inflation system. This inflation system shall consist of one or more blowers and shall include provisions for automatic control to maintain the required inflation pressures. The system shall be designed to prevent over pressurization of the system.
- 2. Additional requirement for air-inflated structures in excess of 1500 square feet in area. In addition to the primary inflation system, in buildings larger than 1500 square feet in area, an auxiliary inflation system shall be provided with sufficient capacity to maintain the inflation of the structure in case of primary failure. The auxiliary inflation system shall operate automatically when there is a loss of internal pressure and when primary blower system becomes inoperable. Wherever an auxiliary inflation system is required, an approved standby power generating system shall be provided. The system shall be equipped with suitable means for automatically starting the generator set upon failure of the normal electrical service and for automatic transfer of all of the required electrical functions at full power within 60 seconds of such service failure.
- B. <u>Blower equipment</u>. Blower equipment in air-inflated structures shall meet all of the following requirements:
 - 1. Blowers shall be powered by continuous-rated motors at the maximum power required for any flow condition as required by the structural design.
 - 2. Blowers shall be provided with inlet screens, belt guards and other protective devices as required by the building official to provide protection from injury.
 - 3. Blowers shall be housed within a weather-protecting structure.
 - 4. Blowers shall be equipped with backdraft check dampers to minimize air loss when inoperative.
 - 5. Not less than two blower units shall be provided, each of which has capacity to maintain full inflation pressure with normal leakage.
 - 6. The blowers shall be designed to be incapable of over pressurization.

- 7. The auxiliary blower unit(s) shall operate automatically if there is any loss of internal pressure or if in operating blower unit becomes inoperative.
- 8. The design inflation pressure and the capacity of each blower system shall be certified by a professional engineer. (NFPA 1:25.5.3.2) (NFPA 101:11.9.3.2)

SECTION 7 ADDITIONAL STANDARDS AND REGULATIONS FOR COOKING IN TEMPORARY STRUCTURES

- A) Portable structures and concession stands as defined herein in which food is prepared and/or served for human consumption (on site or take-away) are required to obtain a permit for food service from the Kalamazoo County Health Department.
- B) Mobile or temporary cooking shall not take place in tents that are open to the public. NFPA 1 50.7.1.6.1.

SECTION 8 CROWD MANAGERS AND FIRE WATCH REQUIREMENTS

In addition to any of the other requirements contained herein or any other Ordinance of the Charter Township of Kalamazoo (such as an Outdoor Gatherings Ordinance), the following regulations shall apply to fairs, crowds, temporary events and/or events at which portable structures are regulated by this Ordinance at which a total of more than 250 individuals are expected, the owner or occupant shall provide crowd managers and fire department watch as follows:

- a. The applicant shall provide Trained Crowd Managers, with a means of emergency responder notification, for all events at a ratio of 1 to 250 people. When the occupant loads exceed 250 individuals, additional trained crowd managers or crowd manager supervisors shall be provided at a ratio of 1 for every 250 occupants. (NFPA 101:12.7.6.1)
- b. The Fire Marshal shall have the authority to require Kalamazoo Township Fire Department Standby Fire Personnel, emergency response equipment, or an approved fire watch when potentially hazardous conditions or a reduction in a life safety feature exist due to the type of performance, display, exhibit, occupancy, contest or activity, an impairment to a fire protection feature, or the number of persons present. (NFPA 1:1.7.17.1)
- c. One (1) Kalamazoo Township Fire Department Fire Watch Personnel with a means of emergency forces notification shall be provided when actual occupant loads exceed 1,000 individuals in addition to the crowd manager requirements of this subsection.

SECTION 9 VIOLATION AND PENALTY Any person, firm, association, partnership, corporation, or governmental entity who violates any of the provisions of this Ordinance or fails to adhere to a site plan approved hereunder; fails to obtain a permit, or fails to provide fire safety equipment or inspections as required herein; fails to adhere to the parameters of a permit issued, fails to remove a portable structure or otherwise violates any provision of this Ordinance shall be deemed to be responsible for a municipal civil infraction as defined by Michigan Statute which shall be punishable by civil fine determined in accordance with the following schedule:

Additionally, the violator shall pay costs which may include all expenses, direct and indirect, which the Charter Township of Kalamazoo has incurred in connection with the municipal civil infraction. In no case, however, shall costs of less than \$10.00 nor more than \$500.00 be ordered. In addition, the Township shall have the right to proceed in any court of competent jurisdiction for the purpose of obtaining an injunction, restraining order, or other appropriate remedy to compel compliance with this Ordinance. Each day that a violation of this Ordinance exists shall constitute a separate violation of this Ordinance.

SEVERABLITY AND SAVINGS CLAUSE

The provisions of this ordinance are hereby declared to be severable. If any clause, sentence, word, section or provision is hereafter declared void or unenforceable for any reason by a court of competent jurisdiction, it shall not affect the remainder of such ordinance which shall continue in full force and effect. Any matters, cases or prosecutions presently pending under an ordinance or ordinance provision that is repealed by this Ordinance may proceed to its natural conclusion as if such provision was in full force and effect.

SECTION 11 REPEAL

All ordinance or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed. Charter Township of Kalamazoo Ordinance No. 596 adopting the NFPA 1 of 2018 as the Township Fire Code is hereby specifically deemed not to be in conflict herewith and no provision thereof is repealed by this ordinance.

SECTION 12 EFFECTIVE DATE

This ordinance shall take effect 30 days after publication, after adoption.

MOBILE FOOD TRUCKS AND TRAILER FIRE SAFETY REQUIREMENTS ORDINANCE

ADOPTED:	
EFFECTIVE:	

An Ordinance to protect the public health, safety and welfare by requiring mobile food trucks and trailers used within the Charter Township of Kalamazoo to meet certain minimum standards for general safety, and fuel and power sources; to address operational and propane system safety; to provide an effective date; to repeal ordinances in conflict herewith; and to provide penalties for violation hereof.

SECTION 1 NAME AND PURPOSE

This ordinance shall be known and cited as the Kalamazoo Charter Township Mobile Food Trucks and Trailer Fire Safety Requirements Ordinance. The purpose is to protect the public health, safety and welfare by requiring mobile food trucks and trailers used within the Charter Township of Kalamazoo to meet certain minimum standards for general safety; and fuel and power sources; to address operational and propane system safety; to provide an effective date; to repeal ordinances in conflict herewith; and to provide penalties for violation hereof.

SECTION 2 DEFINITIONS

The following definitions shall apply to this Ordinance:

- a. Food Truck shall mean a self-propelled structure with motor in which food is prepared and served through a window on the truck. Food trucks do not have interior seating. Food trucks supplying seating under a tent or canopy or within a portable structure shall also be subject to the Charter Township of Kalamazoo Portable Structure Ordinance (Ordinance No. 599, as amended).
- b. Food Trailer –shall mean a portable structure on wheels which is not self-propelled and is capable of being towed in which food is prepared, served and sold through a window on the trailer. Food trailers supplying seating under a tent or canopy or within a portable structure shall also

- be subject to the Charter Township of Kalamazoo Portable Structure Ordinance (Ordinance No. 599, as amended).
- c. "In use" as utilized in this ordinance shall mean preparing to, serving, or selling food from the food truck or food trailer. "In use" does not refer to a food truck or food trailer that is parked or stored in the township on the property of the food truck or trailer owner while not serving food or preparing to serve food.
- d. References to "NFPA" shall mean the "National Fire Protection Association". Book number and section references are provided for ease of the public.

SECTION 3 REQUIREMENTS

An operator of a food truck or food trailer serving or preparing to serve food for sale and/or human consumption within the Charter Township of Kalamazoo is required to adhere to the following requirements in addition to the requirements of any other ordinance and state law for food service:

- a. Obtain permits from the Charter Township of Kalamazoo Fire Marshal prior to service. [1:1.12.8(a)]
- b. There shall be no public seating within the food truck or food trailer.
- c. A food truck or food trailer in use shall be located at least 10 feet away from buildings, structures, vehicles, and any combustible materials. [96:B.13.1; B.13.2]
- d. A food truck or food trailer in use shall ensure that fire department vehicular access is provided for fire lanes and access roads. [1:18.2.4]
- e. A food truck or food trailer in use shall provide clearance for the fire department to access nearby fire hydrants and access fire department connections. [1:13.1.3; 1:13.1.4; 1:13.1.5]
- f. A food truck or trailer in use that utilizes combustible media for cooking shall provide an approved fire extinguishing system. [96:10.1.2]
- g. A food truck or food trailer in use shall install portable fire extinguishers in kitchen cooking areas in accordance with NFPA 10. [96:10.9.3]
- h. A cooking appliance in a food truck or food trailer that produces grease-laden vapors shall be protected by listed fire-extinguishing equipment. [96:14.7.1]
- i. A food truck or food trailer in use shall ensure that all workers present are trained in the proper use of fire extinguishers and extinguishing systems. (96:B.15.1; 10.1.2].
- j. All employees of a food truck or food trailer in use shall know the proper method for shutting off fuel sources ([96:10.4.1]; the proper procedure

- for notifying the local fire department [1:10.14.9 for carnivals only]; and the proper procedure for how to perform simple leak test on gas connections [58:6.16, 58:6.17]
- A food truck or food trailer in use shall install and provide wheel chocks to prevent mobile and temporary cooking units from moving. [96: B.21.5]
- A food truck or food trailer operator shall keep and maintain all record-keeping documents in one location on the mobile cooking operation and shall make such records available to the fire department of the Charter Township of Kalamazoo upon request.

SECTION 4 FOOD TRUCK AND FOOD TRAILER OPERATIONAL SAFETY

In order to protect the public health, safety and welfare and in addition to the other requirements of this Ordinance, a food truck or food trailer operator of a food truck or food trailer in use in the township shall adhere by to following operational safety requirements:

- a. The operator shall not leave cooking equipment unattended while it is still hot.
- b. The operator shall only operate or permit the operation of cooking equipment only when all windows, service hatches, and ventilation sources are fully opened. [96:14.2.2; 96:14.2.3]
- c. The operator shall ensure that all gas supply piping valves and gas container valves are fully closed when the equipment is not in use. [58:6.26.8.3]
- d. The operator shall ensure that all cooking equipment, including the cooking ventilation system, is regularly cleaned and grease removed. [96:11.4]
- e. All mobile or temporary cooking operations shall be separated from other mobile or temporary cooking operations by a clear space distance of 10 ft. [96:B13.2]
- f. The address of the current operational location for all food trucks or food trailers in use in the township shall be posted accessible to all employees. [96:B.15.6]

SECTION 5 FUEL AND POWER SOURCE REGULATIONS APPLICABLE TO FOOD TRUCKS AND TRAILERS

In addition to the other requirements of this Ordinance, a food truck or trailer owner or operator of a food truck or trailer in use in the Charter Township of Kalamazoo shall be required to adhere to the following regulations regarding the cooking fuel and power source(s):

- a. Prior to commencing cooking, the operator shall verify that fuel tanks are filled to the capacity needed for uninterrupted operation during normal operating hours. [1:10.14.10.1]
- b. Refueling shall only be permitted during non-operating hours. [96:B.18.3]
- c. Any engine-driven source of power shall be separated from the public by barriers, such as physical guards, fencing, or enclosures. [96:B.16.2.2]
- d. Any engine-driven source of power shall be turned off and completely shut down prior to refueling from a portable container.
- e. Prior to refueling from a portable container, the operator shall verify that surfaces of engine-driven source of power are cool to the touch.
- f. An operator shall ensure that all electrical appliances, fixtures, equipment, and wiring comply with the NFPA 70®. [96:B.18].
- g. An operator shall ensure that exhaust from engine-driven sources of power comply with the following:

The source of exhaust shall be located at least 10 ft in all directions from openings and air intakes [96:B.13]

The source of exhaust shall be located at least 10 ft from every means of egress [96:B.13]

The source of exhaust shall be directed away from all buildings [1:11.7.2.2]

The source of exhaust shall be directed away from all other cooking vehicles and operations [1:11.7.2.2]

SECTION 6 PROPANE SYSTEM INTEGRITY

In addition to the other requirements of this Ordinance, a food truck or trailer owner or operator of a food truck or trailer in use in the Charter Township of Kalamazoo which utilizes propane for cooking fuel shall adhere to the following regulations regarding the propane system integrity prior to placing such unit in use in the township:

- a. The operator shall ensure that the main shutoff valve on all gas containers is readily accessible at all times. [58:6.26.4.1(3)]
- b. The operator shall ensure that portable gas containers are in the upright position and secured to prevent tipping over. [58:6.26.3.4]
- c. The operator shall perform leak testing on all new gas connections of the gas system. [58:6.16; 58:6.17]
- d. The operator shall perform leak testing on all gas connections affected by replacement of an exchangeable container. [58:6.16; 58:6.17]
- e. The operator shall ensure that where a gas detection system is installed, that it has been tested in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions. [96:B.19.2.2]
- f. The operator shall document all leak testing and shall make documentation available for review by the authorized official. [58:6.26.5.1(M)]
- g. The operator shall ensure that on gas system piping, a flexible connector is installed between the regulator outlet and the fixed piping system. [58:6.26.5.1(B)]

SOLID FUEL REGULATIONS FOR FOOD TRUCKS AND FOOD TRAILERS

In addition to the other requirements of this Ordinance, a food truck or trailer owner or operator of a food truck or trailer in use in the Charter Township of Kalamazoo which utilizing solid fuel (wood, charcoal, or other fuel) for cooking shall adhere to the following additional regulations prior to placing such unit in use in the township:

- a. Such fuel shall not be stored above any heat-producing appliance or vent. [96:14.9.2.2]
- b. Such fuel shall not be stored closer than 3 ft to any cooking appliance. [96:14.9.2.2]

- c. Such fuel is not stored near any combustible flammable liquids, ignition sources, chemicals, and food supplies and packaged goods. [96:14.9.2.7]
- d. Such fuel is not stored in the path of the ash removal or near removed ashes. [96:14.9.2.4]
- e. Ash, cinders, and other fire debris shall be removed from the firebox at regular intervals and at least once a day. [96:14.9.3.6.1; 96:14.9.3.6.2]
- f. Removed ashes, cinders, and other removed fire debris must be placed in a closed, metal container located at least 3 feet from any cooking appliance. [96:14.9.3.8]

SECTION 8 VIOLATION AND PENALTY

Any person, firm, association, partnership, corporation, or governmental entity who violates any of the provisions of this Ordinance or fails to adhere to a site plan approved hereunder; fails to obtain a permit, or fails to provide fire safety equipment or inspections as required herein; fails to adhere to the parameters of a permit issued, fails to remove a temporary structure or otherwise violates any provision of this Ordinance shall be deemed to be responsible for a municipal civil infraction as defined by Michigan Statute which shall be punishable by civil fine determined in accordance with the following schedule:

Re: Parchment Police Service Contract

Information

The Township of Kalamazoo Police Department (TKPD) has been providing police services to the City of Parchment since 2011. This contract is for a term of four (4)years and provides the City of Parchment continued police service from TKPD, while simultaneously providing increased police coverage to Kalamazoo Township.

This agreement was approved by the Parchment City Commission on Monday May 21, 2018.

Request

That the Charter Township of Kalamazoo Board of Trustees approve the contract for police services presented, and allow the Township Supervisor to sign on behalf of the Township.

This contract has been approved to form by Attorney Roxanne Seeber.

POLICE SERVICES AGREEMENT

The Agreement is made this day of May 21, 2018, by and between the City of Parchment, a Michigan municipal corporation, 650 S Riverview Drive, Parchment, Michigan (hereinafter "City"), and Kalamazoo Charter Township, a Michigan municipal corporation, 1720 Riverview Drive, Kalamazoo, Michigan (hereinafter "Township").

Whereas, Act 35 of the Public acts of 1951 (MCL 124.1 et seq) in pertinent part authorizes a municipal corporation to contract with one or more other municipal corporations for the performance, jointly or by any one or more on behalf of all, of any service which each would have the power to perform separately; and

Whereas, the Parchment City Charter requires the City to provide police protection services within the City; and

Whereas, the City administration recommends and the City Commission finds that the most cost-effective method of continuing to provide police protection services within the City is to contract with the Kalamazoo Charter Township to have Township police officers be sworn as and serve as Parchment police officers on a contractual pasis; and

Whereas, the City and Township have previously, entered into agreement(s) to allow the Township police department to provide and undertake police protection services in the City; which agreement(s) are due for renewal and which both the City and the Township have deemed to be satisfactory and mutually beneficial; as such the City and the Township reaffirm their commitment to one another in providing professional police services to our community, and

Whereas, the City wishes to enter into an agreement with the Township by which the Township would provide police protection services within the City.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the promises, covenants and conditions hereinafter contained, it is hereby agreed by and between the parties hereto as follows:

- 1. The City hereby calls upon the Township to furnish, and the Township agrees to provide, police protection services within the City, subject to the terms and conditions contained in this Agreement.
- 2. Commencing July 1, 2018, the Township shall have a Township police officer assigned to patrol within the North District during the Township Police Department's day and afternoon patrol shifts on a daily basis. In addition, the Township's Police Department shall provide full police services to the City during the midnight shift. The Township agrees to provide the necessary associated personnel and equipment in support of the police services provided hereunder.

Furthermore, the Township agrees that there will be no additional charge to the City when more than one officer is needed on calls for service; for officers held past the end of their shift on overtime to complete work; for detectives; crime scene technicians, or when staffing allows for additional officers provided out of existing scheduled staff.

- 3. Township police officers providing police services pursuant to this Agreement shall also be sworn as officers of the City of Parchment.
- 4. Township officers assigned to provide police protection services pursuant to this agreement shall enforce City ordinances as well as State law. Officers will be assigned to perform ordinance enforcement in the City of Parchment. The assistance, at this time, will consist of identifying violations, resolving ordinance violations, issuing citations and appearing in court. The officers will be a liaison to the City on ordinance enforcement activities.
- 5. The police protection services provided hereunder shall include the continuation of community outreach and proactive programs directly to the Parchment Schools.
- 6. At the request of the City, the Township shall provide supplemental police services to the City. The City shall pay the Township over and above the sum set forth herein for such services in accordance with this paragraph. The rate for supplemental services, shall be one and a half (1 ½) times the assigned officers' regular rate and shall include a fringe benefit rate which shall include the additional fringe benefit amounts calculated on the basis of the police contract (FICA, work comp., etc.).
- 7. In an effort to identify any cost adjustments that occur with the negotiation of the collective bargaining agreement (CBA) with the Township and the Kalamazoo Township Police Officers Association (KTPOA), the parties agree that it is advantageous that this Agreement shall be for a term of four years. This agreement shall begin on July 1, 2018 and conclude on May 31, 2022. The City agrees to pay the Township \$304,173.00 for the first year of police service rendered hereunder, such sum to be paid in 12 equal monthly installments beginning July 1, 2018, and on or before the first day of each month thereafter until paid in full.
 - A. This cost reflects the officer's wage estimated at the CBA's Police Officer 4 (PO-04) rate, along with ancillary costs.
 - B. Future costs will reflect an annual step rate used for the estimated wage, up to the highest police officer rate within the CBA; currently PO6. This practice is used to provide some relief to the City, reflects past agreements and identifies good-faith and relationship building on behalf of the Township.
 - a. July 1, 2018 to June 30, 2019; PO4
 - b. July 1, 2019 to June 30, 2020; PO5
 - c. July 1, 2020 to June 30, 2021; PO6

- d. July 1, 2021 to June 30, 2022; PO6
- C. Not less than 120 days prior to July 1st of each year, the Township shall provide the City with a written statement of the cost to the City for police services for the upcoming term, which cost will be payable as prescribed in section B. The City shall pay the costs of police services in 12 monthly installments commencing on July 1st of each year as identified in this paragraph 7.
- 8. It is recognized and agreed that during the course of the 4-year term of this contract the cost of the police services provided hereunder may have to be increased as a result of increased costs to the Township due to issues beyond the township's control. The Township shall have the right to commensurately increase the cost to be paid by the City hereunder, subject to the following:
 - A. The Township shall give the City not less than 60 days advance written notice of the increase in the costs of police services and the reason for the same to be paid for the current term by the City hereunder.
 - B. The City shall have a 60 days' notice period, before July 1, to decide whether it will terminate this Agreement, or to attempt to negotiate with the Township a mutually acceptable adjustment in the level of police services provided hereunder.
- 9. If the City desires to extend this Agreement beyond the four-year term set forth above, the City shall notify the Township of this in writing not less than 90 days prior to the expiration of this Agreement. As soon as practicable after receiving the City's request, the Township shall provide the City with a written statement of the cost for such additional service. If the parties mutually desire to so proceed, they shall then enter into an Addendum to extend this Agreement accordingly. The extension shall be on an annual basis unless otherwise agreed to by the parties. Further extensions of this Agreement may be made in the same manner set forth in this section.
- 10. All Township police officers providing service to the City pursuant to this Agreement shall remain directly accountable to the Township through its Police Chief.
- 11. The Township agrees to prepare and present a quarterly and annual report of law enforcement activity performed by Township police officers within the City pursuant to this Agreement. The Township further agrees to prepare and submit to the State of Michigan such reports as the State may require with regard to the police services rendered under this Agreement. The Township further agrees that it will maintain and provide records of the police services rendered under this Agreement for the same time and in the same manner as it does for Township records.
- 12. The legal representation of the City in any judicial proceedings involving a violation of a

City ordinance shall be conducted by the City Attorney, the cost of such legal representation being borne solely by the City.

- 13. The Township covenants and agrees, to the greatest extent permitted by law, to defend, indemnify and hold harmless the City and its officers and employees from any and all claims, suites, damages, loss or liability which may occur arising out of any claims of negligence of wrongdoing by the Township, its officers or employees in connection with the performance of this Agreement. The City covenants and agrees, to the greatest extent permitted by law, to defend, indemnify and hold harmless the Township and its officers and employees from any and all claims, suits, damages, loss or liability which may occur arising out of any claims of negligence or wrongdoing by the City, its officers or employees in connection with the performance of this Agreement. The foregoing shall not be considered a waiver of governmental immunity attributed to the City or the township or its officers of employees.
- 14. The Township agrees that throughout the life of this Agreement it shall cause the City, its officials and employees to be named as additional insureds on the general liability, motor vehicle liability and police professional liability insurance coverage held by it. The City agrees that throughout the life of this Agreement it shall cause the Township and its officers and employees to be named as additional insureds on the general liability and police professional liability insurance coverage held by it. Both the City and the Township agree that they shall not reduce their aforementioned insurance coverage during the life of this Agreement.
- 15. This Agreement may be terminated for material breach only after the other party is given written notice of the alleged material breach and allowed 30 days to remedy the same.
- 16. Any waiver, alteration or modification of any of the provisions of this Agreement shall not be valid unless in writing and executed by the parties with the same formality as this Agreement. Any waiver by any party of any provision of the Agreement or any right or option under this Agreement shall not be controlling, nor shall it prevent or estop such party from thereafter enforcing such provision, right or option. The failure of any party to insist in any one or more instances upon the strict performance of any of the terms or provisions of this Agreement by another party shall not be construed as a waiver or relinquishment for the future of any such term or provision, and the same shall continue in full force and effect.
- 17. No provision in this Agreement is to be interpreted for or against any party because that party or that party's legal representative drafted the provision. This agreement was drafted in Michigan and it is agreed that Michigan law shall control.

- 18. This Agreement constitutes the entire agreement of the parties. All other prior or contemporaneous agreements, understandings, representations and statements, oral or written, are hereby terminated.

Information

The Township of Kalamazoo Police Department (TKPD) currently has a vacancy for a service officer. This position is currently paid at a salary grade 2 of the part time technical, office & paraprofessional classification. TKPD proposes to discontinue the service officer position into the foreseeable future.

The availability of qualified applicants for police officer applicants continues to be a problem nationwide. TKPD is seeking to be more proactive in recruiting, developing and hiring local talent to fill these positions.

It is the intent of TKPD to begin a cadet program, thereby recruiting persons interested in a career in law enforcement and introduce them into the law enforcement field. We feel these are opportunities to an economically diverse population and fulfil our commitment to community policing and the 21^{st} century policing model; promoting community outreach and developing local talent, who may otherwise not be exposed to law enforcement. Simultaneously, this employment opportunity provides a recruiting pipeline for our agency from a pool that may have the same opportunity.

Information

The Township of Kalamazoo Police Department (TKPD) is in the process of transitioning to consolidating with other local agencies in the Kalamazoo County Consolidated Dispatch Authority (KCCDA). In doing so, TKPD will be shedding dispatch services when the KCCDA takes over, currently projected for the end of October 2018. In the meantime, TKPD requires this essential service and the individual expertise these dispatchers have to continue police, fire and EMS communications. To be without our dispatch personnel, would put great strain on the operations and personnel of our agency. Without our dispatch personnel, police officers would be required to cover these duties, being paid at a higher wage or overtime rate while also being away from their primary duties.

In an effort to maintain current operations, it is my request to provide an incentive for our essential dispatch staff. This incentive would only be offered to our current dispatchers. Our proposal is to pay current dispatchers \$500 per year of service, with a maximum of \$5,000 per employee. As a stipulation to this offer, the employees would be required to stay in their current position until such time as the KCCDA goes into operation and released from their position as determined by the Chief of Police.

Projections

Dispatcher Deb Spencer: 27 years of service = \$5,000

Dispatcher Lorenzo Herbert: 9 years of service = \$4,500 (likely to reach 10 years)

Dispatcher Jefferson Koch: 7 years of service = \$3,500

Dispatcher Brittany Sorensen: 2 years of service = \$1,000 (likely to reach 3 years)

Estimated total up to \$15,000

Due to other staff vacancies, there is availability in our operations budget for such an incentive.

Request

That the Township Board approve the unanimous Personnel Advisory Committee recommendation for the Police Chief to offer an incentive to TKPD Dispatchers.
