KABA update property maintenance inspections will increase from \$55 to \$100, and court appearances will go to \$100 per hour. Citizens can get involved by reporting streetlights that are out, or by helping their neighbors.

Trustee Glass reported progress on the new Township website. She is attending Citizens Police Academy.

Clerk Miller said there is still plenty of time to apply for an absentee ballot for the Nov. 2 election.

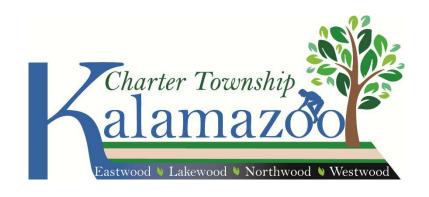

RE: Portable Traffic Speed Notification and Data Collection Sign purchase

Kalamazoo Township residents have repeatedly perceived their primary public safety concern to be traffic related matters. The Township of Kalamazoo Police Department (TKPD) investigates close to 300 traffic crashes each year. A significant portion of these crashes involve at-fault motorists exceeding the posted speed limit.

Law enforcement continues to look for ways to first educate and then deter motorists from speeding, generate data to direct enforcement activities and increase roadway safety. Speed related crashes frequently involve increased potential for significant injuries and property loss. In 2020 and 2021 there has been a marked increase in fatalities and serious injuries in traffic crashes both nationally, and within Michigan. In a study conducted by the University of Michigan and the Michigan State Police the yearly costs of traffic crashes is estimated to be \$4.8 billion.

By purchasing and deploying Portable Traffic Speed Notification and Data Collection signs and analyzing the retrieved data, we hope to deter motorists from speeding, increase roadway safety, and validate complaints. This information provides the police department data driven enforcement directives.

While examining available options the All Traffic Solutions Shield 12 sign is battery powered and easily deployable to provide a wide-range of opportunities and locations for its use. It also includes a comprehensive software suite, built-in camera if triggered by tampering, and violator alert notification. The total cost of the Shield 12 sign including the first year of traffic software is \$4,840.00. The additional yearly cost of the software is \$1,500.00.

The Township of Kalamazoo Police Department has applied for traffic safety grants through AAA the past two years and applied for a Par Plan grant to purchase radar signs, and all three times the grant applications were denied.

With repeated and increased complaints about perceived speeding from our community, the need to address additional motorist safety needs we recommend purchasing two All Traffic Solutions Shield 12 signs for \$9,680.00 for departmental use. These funds are available within the police department's capital account.

TKPD has received notice that our grant proposal submitted to the Office of Community-Oriented Policing Services (COPS) Community Policing Development (CPD) has been approved. As part of this proposal, we have requested funds to support a civilian, part-time Accreditation Support Manager position to assist the Administration with achieving accreditation through the Michigan Law Enforcement Accreditation Commission (MLEAC).

Earlier this year, the Township Board of Trustees authorized additional sworn police officer positions, one of which the Chief of Police intends to utilize as an Accreditation Manager. This dedication of personnel and resources to earn accreditation through MLEAC will demonstrate our police department's continued commitment to building trust and legitimacy with our community through increased transparency and accountability.

In pursuit of this goal, the primary role of the proposed Accreditation Support Manager will be to facilitate and organize the accreditation application and evaluation process. The Accreditation Support Manager will work in concert with the sworn Accreditation Manager, as well as the Chief of Police and other designated Command Staff, to complete the requisite tasks prior to the on-site assessment by MLEAC. The Accreditation Support Manager will be tasked with coordination and project management, while the Accreditation Manager will be responsible for vetting the content of policy and written directives and compliance with MLEAC standards prior to review by the Chief of Police and designated Command Staff.

The Accreditation Support Manager would work less than 30 hours per week over a 24-month period at a wage (Grade 4 of the Kalamazoo Charter Township Wage Scale) ranging between \$21.43 and \$22.14 per hour, based on experience.
