

RESOLUTION 26-02

AGRICULTURAL SECURITY AREA AMENDMENT

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Cherry, Butler County, Pennsylvania (the "Township") established an Agricultural Security Area on May 5, 1998, according to the Agricultural Security Law (3P.S.Sections 901-915) and

WHEREAS, the Agricultural Security Law provides procedures for property to be added to the Agricultural Security Area between the previous seven year review and the next seven year review, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors received an application on July 11, 2025, from one Rosemary Simmons to add property located at 160 Harrisville Road consisting of 130 total acres to the Cherry Township Agricultural Security Area, and


WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors has taken no action to oppose the addition of this acreage to the Agricultural Security Area within 180 days post receipt of the application; therefore the application is deemed approved,


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of Cherry Township, that:

Section 1, the Board of Supervisors declare and accept the amendment to the Agricultural Security Area for Cherry Township,

Section 2. The amendment to the original proposal shall be recorded in the office of the Recorder of Deeds, Butler County Court House, under the list of miscellaneous documents.


