

ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PER CAPITA TAX ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF CHERRY, BUTLER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, TO IMPOSE A PER CAPITA TAX ON THOSE RESIDENTS OF CHERRY TOWNSHIP HAVING ATTAINED EIGHTEEN (18) YEARS OF AGE.

ORDINANCE NO. 4

WHEREAS, the Township of Cherry, has a duly enacted Per Capita Tax Ordinance; and,

WHEREAS, under and pursuant to the authority granted by the provisions of Act #511 of the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, approved December 31, 1965, known as the "The Local Tax Enabling Act", the Supervisors of Cherry Township intend to enact an Ordinance providing for the assessment, levy and collection of a per capita tax of ~~\$10~~^{\$5} per person upon all persons residing in the said Cherry Township, eighteen (18) years of age and over, for the calendar year 1973. This Ordinance being an amendment to the existing ordinance and reducing the age of taxables from twenty-one (21) to eighteen (18) years of age; and,

WHEREAS, it has been estimated that approximately Dollars (\$50⁰⁰) in additional revenues can be realized from the said amendment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT AND IT HEREBY IS ORDAINED AND RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of Cherry Township, Butler County, Pennsylvania, that:

1. Each resident or inhabitant, over eighteen (18) years of age, in the Township of Cherry, shall annually pay for the use of the township, a per capita tax of ~~Ten (\$10.00)~~^{Five \$5.00} Dollars.

2. This Ordinance shall become effective thirty (30) days after the date of its adoption.
