

CHERRY TOWNSHIP SPECIAL MEETING

JULY 25, 2022

A special meeting of the Cherry Township Supervisors was held on July 25, 2022 at 3:00 p.m. in the Township Municipal Building. Those present were Mr. David Mishler, Mr. William Smith, and Mrs. Carolyn Yeager.

Mr. Mishler called the meeting to order at 3:01 p.m. The purpose of the meeting is to open bids for the section of Redbrush Road that was inadvertently left off of the tar and chip bid forms for which an award was given on April 5, 2022.

One bid was received as follows:

Russell Standard - 8567 square yards, surface treatment

\$ 5.23 per sq. yd. total bid: \$44,805.41.

Mrs. Yeager stated that the original bid from April 5, was awarded for \$129,037.35, making the total for tar and chip projects this year \$173,842.76.

Available funding for this project: \$ 55,000 - ARPA Federal Funding

55,000 - Building Fund – transferred to General Fund

31,000 - Liquid Fuels Fund Budgeted

27,000 - Natural Gas Impact Fees

\$168,000

We are approximately \$6000 short to cover the costs, but we can use the Road Maintenance line item from the liquid fuels budget to make up that amount.

Mr. Mishler made a motion to award the bid to Russell Standard, in the amount of \$44,805.41. Mr. Smith seconded the motion. The motion carried. Mrs. Yeager will send the signed contract to Russell Standard.

Mr. Mishler made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Mr. Smith seconded the motion. The motion carried. The meeting was adjourned at 3:15 p.m.
