

Important Dates to Remember

7/15/24 – 8/9/24	Nomination period for the November 5, 2024 election During the nomination period, nomination papers are available at the City Clerk's Office Monday through Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Please contact City Clerk Michelle Estabillo at 650-977-83111 to schedule an appointment to receive nomination papers and orientation materials. There is no filing fee to receive or file nomination papers.
8/10/24 – 8/14/24, 5:00 p.m.	If an incumbent fails to file a Declaration of Candidacy by 5:00 p.m. on 8/9/24, there is a 5-calendar-day extension period during which any candidate, other than the incumbent, may file.
8/15/2024, 11:00 a.m.	Randomized Alphabet Drawing: the Secretary of State will conduct a random drawing of letters of the alphabet to determine the order in which candidates appear on the ballot.
9/9/24 – 10/22/24	Filing period for write-in candidates to obtain and file nomination documents.
9/26/24	Deadline for filing 1 st pre-election campaign statement FPPC Form 460 covering the period of 7/1/24 - 9/21/24, or FPPC Form 470 covering the filing period 1/1/24 - 12/31/24.
10/7/24 – 10/29/24	Vote by Mail (VBM) ballots are mailed to voters. After November 1, VBM ballots may be obtained from the County Elections Office.
10/21/24	Last day to register to vote in the November 5, 2024 election.
10/24/24	Deadline for filing 2 nd pre-election campaign statement FPPC Form 460 covering the period of 9/22/24 - 10/19/24.
11/5/24	Election Day
