- Payments Accepted: Cash, Check and Credit Card
- Make Checks Payable to: Town of Colma
- All registration is accepted on a first come, first serve basis unless otherwise noted
- If you are a Colma resident you must come to the Colma Community Center to set up your online account to receive the resident rate.
- All facility reservations must be done in person.
- Participants may cancel recreation programs two weeks prior to the start of the program without penalty. If participants cancel recreation programs within two weeks of the start of the program, refunds will not be returned and participants may be responsible for paying the full cost of the program, if prepayments to third parties have been made. Also, it is important that you attend recreation programs that you register for, if you fail to attend recreation programs you may also be responsible for the full cost of the program.
- For department cancellation of programs, if eligible, your refund will be processed and check sent to you within three to four weeks.

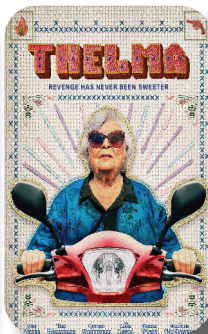
