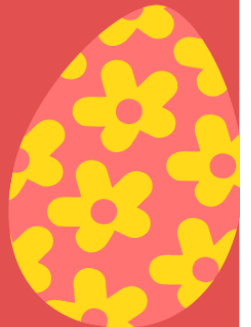
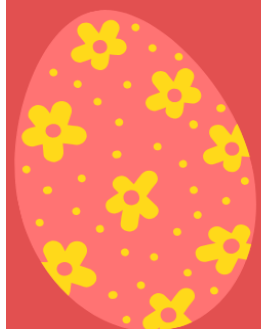

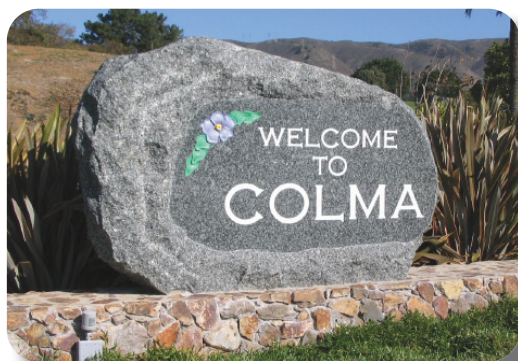

Step back in time and explore the rich history of Colma at the Colma Historical Museum, open every Saturday from 12:00 PM to 3:00 PM. Admission is free, so come by and discover something new!

This winter the Freight Shed exhibits are being refreshed. Exhibits include agricultural equipment, Colma's flower shops and monument companies, and railroad related items. In the main museum, built in 1911, you'll find the Cemetery Room with, among other items, a traveling undertakers table and two headstones from San Francisco's Laurel Hill Cemetery. **Cancellations More Than 14 Days Before Start:** Full refund will be issued.

**Cancellations Less Than 14 Days Before Start:** Refunds will not be issued.

**Medical Emergencies or Illness:** May be exempt from the above policy, but a medical certification from your doctor is required.

**Cancellation Requests:** Must be submitted in writing.

**No-Shows or Cancellations After the Program Starts:** No credits or refunds will be given unless a written medical certification is provided.

### REGISTRATION TIPS

- Payments accepted: Cash, Check and Credit Card.
- Make checks payable to: Town of Colma.
- All registration is accepted on a first come, first serve basis unless otherwise noted.
- If you are a Colma resident, you must come to the Colma Community Center to set up your online account to receive the resident rate.
- All facility reservations must be done in person at the Colma Community Center.
- Participants may cancel recreation programs up to two weeks prior to the program start without penalty. Cancellations made within two weeks of the program start are non-refundable, and participants may be responsible for the full cost of the program if prepayments have been made to third parties. Additionally, it is important to attend the recreation programs you register for. Failure to attend may result in being responsible for the full cost of the program.
- For department cancellation of programs, if eligible, your refund will be processed and check sent to you within three to four weeks.
- Class details, including dates, times, and locations, provided in this edition of the activity guide may change after publication.

Participants will receive eight monthly subsidized rides at the cost of \$5 per ride (tip not included). Rides are provided by Serra Yellow Cab and accessible vehicles are available at no additional cost.

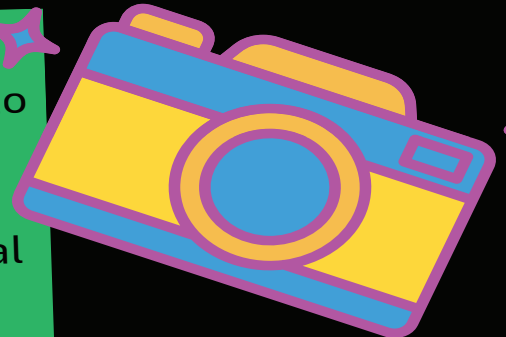

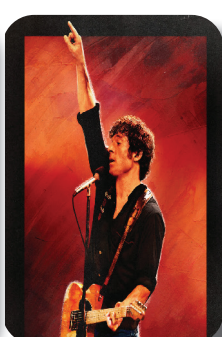
