




Town of Colma Drought Garden Location:

Town of Colma—Drought Tolerant Sample Garden

In response to the worst drought on record in California, the Town of Colma's City Council complied with Governor Jerry Brown's April 1, 2015 Executive order to reduce water use throughout the State. The City Council directed a reduction in irrigation to its landscaped areas by twenty-five percent.

In an effort to show the local community how beautiful a garden can be using a minimal amount of water, the City Council directed the installation of a drought tolerant sample garden. The garden includes a few plants native to San Bruno Mountain and California, and can be purchased and found locally at the Home Depot and Mission Blue Nursery. The Town would like to thank their good friends and partners at the Home Depot in Colma for its generous donation of drought tolerant plants to the Garden.
