Dear Recycling Business Owner,

Effective July 1, 2012, the Town of Colma requires all non-franchised<sup>1</sup> recyclers that collect recyclable materials from businesses in Colma to obtain a Recycler's Permit.

Here are the necessary steps to get your Recycler's Permit:

- Complete the Recyclers Permit application and Business Registration Application both available at the Town of Colma Planning Department at 1190 El Camino, Colma, 94014 (650-757-8888) or download the applications from the Town website: <u>www.colma.ca.gov</u>.
- Mail or bring in your applications with a check for \$250 payable to the Town of Colma. This fee covers the \$225 Recyclers Permit fee and the Town of Colma's \$25 Business Registration fee.
- 3. Make sure you complete the quarterly recycling report (sample reports available at the Planning Department and www.colma.ca.gov). Send completed quarterly reports to <u>recycle@colma.ca.gov</u> or mail to the Planning Department, 1190 El Camino, Colma, 94014.
