RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends that the City Council adopt the following resolution:

RESOLUTION DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION HELD ON NOVEMBER 8, 2016, AND SUCH OTHER MATTERS AS PROVIDED BY LAW

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The attached resolution (and exhibit to the resolution) is required by state law to declare the results of the election.

FISCAL IMPACT

This action has no fiscal impact.

BACKGROUND

According to state law, the city elections official has 28 days to canvass the returns and count the votes (*Election Code* sec 10262). Subsequently thereafter, the elections official shall prepare a certified statement of the results of the election and submit it to the governing body within 30 days of the election (Elections Code 15372). In Colma's case, the City Clerk is the city elections official, and the Town has contracted with the County to physically count the votes. The County has provided the certified statement of the results of the results of the election to the Town.

The Council is then required to meet at its usual place of meeting no later than the next regularly scheduled city council meeting (or at a special meeting called for this purpose) to declare the results and to install the newly elected officers (*Election Code* sec 10262).

State law further states that at the meeting at which the declaration of the election results for a general municipal election is made the installation of elected officials shall occur. The City Council must also choose one of its members as Mayor, and one of its members as Mayor Pro Tempore/Vice-Mayor (Government Code 36801)].

ANALYSIS

The election was held on November 8, 2016. The law sets forth a specific procedure (as outlined above) for declaring the results of the election. In accordance with the law, the County Elections Officer has conducted a canvass of the votes and has certified the results to the Colma City Council (Exhibit A to proposed Resolution). The city council must now adopt a resolution officially declaring the results of the election. (Elections Code § 10260-10265) The proposed resolution meets the requirements of law.

CONCLUSION

Staff recommends the Council approve the attached resolution declaring the results of the November 8, 2016 election.

RESOLUTION NO. 2016-## OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF COLMA

RESOLUTION DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION HELD ON NOVEMBER 8, 2016, AND SUCH OTHER MATTERS AS PROVIDED BY LAW

The City Council of the Town of Colma, California, does resolve:

1. Background.

(a) A General Municipal Election was held and conducted in the Town of Colma, County of San Mateo, California, on Tuesday, November 8, 2016, as required by law.

(b) Notice of Election was given in time, form and manner as provided by law; candidates were nominated to fill the vacancy or vacancies as provided by law; voting precincts were properly established; election officers were appointed; and in all respects the election was held and conducted and the votes were cast, received and canvassed and the returns made and declared in time, form, and manner as required by the provisions of the laws of the State of California relating to general law cities; and

(c) The San Mateo County Elections Official has canvassed the returns of the election and has certified the results to the City Council of the Town of Colma, which results are received, attached and made a part hereof as Exhibit A.

2. Declaration of Results.

The City Council declares and determines that:

(a) Number of Ballots. The whole number of ballots cast in the precinct, the whole number of absent voter ballots cast in the City, the whole number of provisional ballots cast in the City, and the total number of ballots cast in the City is set forth in the Certificate of Election from the San Mateo County Elections Officer, which is attached hereto as Exhibit A and made a part hereof.

(b) Election of Three Council Members.

(1) The names of the persons for the vacant offices of members of the City Council are as follows:

RAQUEL "RAE" GONZALEZ JOHN IRISH GOODWIN DIANA ISABEL COLVIN LAURA WALSH BARRY B. LAZARO

(2) The number of votes given at each precinct and the number of votes given in the city to each of the above named persons for the respective offices for which the

persons were candidates are listed in Exhibit A attached. The City Council does declare and determine that the following persons were each elected as Member of the Town of Colma City Council for the full term of four years:

> RAQUEL "RAE" GONZALEZ JOHN IRISH GOODWIN DIANA ISABEL COLVIN

3. Orders.

(a) The City Clerk shall immediately make and deliver to each of the persons so elected a Certificate of Election signed by the City Clerk and authenticated. The City Clerk or some other duly authorized person shall administer to each person elected the Oath of Office prescribed in the Constitution of the State of California and shall have them subscribe to it and file it in the office of the City Clerk. Each and all of the persons so elected shall then be inducted into the respective office to which they have been elected.

(b) The City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this resolution and enter it into the book of original resolutions, and upon entry thereof, this Resolution shall constitute the official record of the results of said election.
