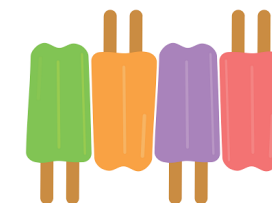
COLMA CITIZENS' ADVISORY SCHOLARSHIPS

CITY MANAGER'S UPDATE

May is always a busy month for Town staff, as we are putting the finishing touches on the next-year's budget for City Council's consideration. I'm pleased to say Fiscal Year 2017-18's budget is, once again, balanced and includes a surplus. This is largely attributable to the Town's past and ongoing fiscal prudence.

You may have noticed that Carmax has put its sign up on the fencing along upper Serramonte Boulevard, and that the structural steel for the building has been erected. We are anticipating a late-fall opening of the used car store, which will bring a nice shot in the arm of new sales tax revenue.

Also under construction is the new Black Bear Diner, which will be located where Fresh Choice was in the Serra Center. This restaurant is eagerly anticipated, bringing a new place for Colma residents and visitors to sit down for a fresh meal. I can personally attest to the deliciousness of their chicken fried steak and eggs -- it's amazing, and the portions are huge.

One of the things I truly enjoy about being a City Manager is being able to recognize and work with various groups in the Town. For example, at the May 10 City Council meeting, we had two presentations: one a presentation of the Colma Citizens' Advisory Committee's student scholarships and one a proclamation for Public Service Week.

The scholarships are sponsored by Lucky Chances and are a tribute to how much the card room gives back to this community. Since 2000 they have presented \$302,049 in scholarships.

The proclamation for Public Service week is a small token of appreciation for all of our public employees -- those men and women who have dedicated their professional lives to making their communities better places. I am truly lucky to work with, and for, such committed people. They are just another reason why "It's Great To Be Alive In Colma!"

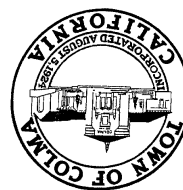
