



# TOWN OF COLMA REBATE PROGRAM FOR RESIDENTS BUYING WATER CONSERVING PRODUCTS

The Town of Colma is offering a rebate to residents who purchase and install qualifying water conserving appliances or products or reduce water through landscaping upgrades. **The program is limited to one Town resident per residential parcel or residential unit or a residential HOA. Rebate is up to 25% of the cost of a qualifying purchase (see attached list). Total Town rebate amount is limited to \$500.**

Details of the rebate program are as follows:

1. Only one Town resident per residential parcel or residential unit is eligible for the rebate program. The program also includes a one-time rebate to a residential HOA for water efficient landscape upgrades. The Department of Public Works will track the residential parcels or units associated with a rebate request.
2. The overall program will total \$2,000 in available funding in FY 2016-17
3. One Town resident per residential parcel or residential unit (or a residential HOA) is eligible for up to a 25 percent rebate of the Purchase Price for qualifying purchases. The total allowable rebate amount per parcel or unit is \$500. The Purchase Price is the price paid for the qualifying purchase, excluding sales tax, minus any reduction in the price as a result of the application of any other rebates as determined by the Town.
4. Qualified purchases must meet the following criteria:
  - a. Must be items that provide for water savings, such as high efficiency appliances (laundry machines, dishwashers, etc.), low-flow toilets, shower heads, etc. Eligible appliances and toilets must be on the San Francisco Water District's rebate list found under the Rebates and Incentives tab at [www.sfwater.org](http://www.sfwater.org).
  - b. Items must be purchased within the Town of Colma. A valid receipt is required for all rebates.
  - c. The rebate is for purchased goods only (not labor-related costs).
5. The Town reserves the right to deny an application if it is inconsistent with the Program

**By participating in this rebate program, the property owner or purchaser has acknowledged that the fixture or purchased items has been installed on a residential property within the Town of Colma. If this is found not to be the case, the rebate shall be forfeited and returned to the Town.**

**Below is a list of eligible products which are eligible for a rebate. Residents are encouraged to take advantage of all available rebates:**

#### **Toilets:**

Toilets must be 1.28 Gallons or less on the attached list:

### **Dishwashers:**

Dish Washers must be ENERGY STAR certified. Provide proof of ENERGY STAR certification with your receipt from a Colma retailer and attach to this application.

### **Rain Barrels:**

Any rainwater harvesting barrel purchased within Colma is eligible.

### **Irrigation:**

Only high efficiency irrigation controllers, spray heads or drip lines are eligible for a rebate. NOT PVC piping or soil amendments. Any Smart Irrigation Controller from the CalWater approved list is eligible for a rebate:
