# **Town of Colma Identification Cards**

In order to participate in Town of Colma Recreation Programs at the Colma resident rate, residents must first obtain a Town of Colma Resident Card.

Town of Colma Resident Cards are free to residents and can be obtained at the Colma Community Center.

Residents must show multiple proofs of residency when applying for a Town of Colma Resident Card (i.e., driver's license, utility bill, phone bill, bank statement, etc.)

# **Program Participation Minimums**

In order to provide a positive experience for residents, each class, program, or activity has a minimum participation requirement. From time to time, a program may be cancelled due to minimum participation numbers not being met. All participants are urged to enroll early to avoid programs being cancelled.

# Program Registration & Facility Reservations

Registration for all programs listed begins upon receipt of the Recreation Guide, unless otherwise noted. You can register for programs in person, or online. Please remember, if you are a Colma resident you must come to the Colma Community Center to set up your online account. All facility reservations must be done in person. Accepted forms of payment are cash, checks or credit cards

Participants may cancel recreation programs two weeks prior to the start of the program without penalty. If participants cancel recreation programs within two weeks of the start of the program, refunds will not be returned and participants may be responsible for paying the full cost of the program if prepayments to third parties have been made. Also, it is important that you attend recreation programs that you register for, if you fail to attend recreation programs you may also be responsible for the full cost of the program.

For department cancellation of programs, if eligible, your refund will be processed and check sent to you within three to four weeks.




