Sig Sauer P320 Duty Handgun Qualification Course

Purpose:

This training exercise is designed as a static line qualification course of fire. Its purpose is to challenge the officers and provide the range staff with an opportunity to evaluate the basic marksmanship skills of the officers within a designated time.

Objective:

The objective of this course is to apply safe and effective gun handling skills while demonstrating the ability to accurately and consistently hit the target.

Equipment:

Duty handgun, Sig Sauer P320 45 ACP, and four fully loaded magazines (41 rounds) on the officer's person as they are normally carried on duty.

Detectives are required to have a fully loaded duty handgun and holster with at least one spare magazine as carried on duty.

Standard:

To complete this course of fire, officers must demonstrate the ability to accurately and consistently hit the designated target from the proper firing position, use the proper draw stroke, exhibit safe weapons handling, properly scan, assess and move as designated.

Disqualifiers:

Any round off target, over allotted time, improper weapon handling, failure to scan, assess and move, or any other range safety violation.

1. Begin at the **15 yard line**. Upon the command of threat, the officer will move off line while drawing and presenting their weapon. The officer will fire **three rounds with strong side supported in five seconds**. The officer should scan and assess before holstering (**repeat one more time**).
2. Upon the command of threat, the officer will move off line while drawing and presenting their weapon. The officer will **fire four rounds with strong side supported in six seconds**, scan/assess before holstering.
3. Upon the command of threat, the officer will move off line while drawing and presenting their weapon. The officer will **fire six rounds strong side supported in eight seconds**, scan/assess before holstering.
4. Move to the **10 yard line**. Upon the command of threat, the officer will move off line while drawing and presenting their weapon. The officer will **fire five rounds strong side supported in seven seconds**, scan/assess before holstering.

Upon the command of threat, the officer will move off line while drawing and presenting their weapon. The officer will fire **five rounds strong side unsupported in seven seconds**, scan/assess before holstering.

5. Move to the **7 yard line**. Upon the command of threat, the officer will move off line while drawing and presenting their weapon. The officer will **fire five rounds strong side supported in seven seconds**, scan/assess before holstering. (Repeat one more time)
6. Move to the **5 yard line**. Upon the command of threat, the officer will move off line while drawing and presenting their weapon. The officer will fire **two rounds strong side supported in four seconds**, scan/assess before holstering.
7. Upon the command of threat, the officer will move off line while drawing and presenting their weapon. The officer will conduct a **failure to neutralize drill strong side supported (three rounds)**, scan/assess before holstering.

Off-Duty Handgun Qualification Course

PURPOSE:

This training exercise is designed to test basic marksmanship while drawing a weapon from concealment as if off-duty or in plain clothes.

OBJECTIVE:

The objective of this exercise is to apply safe and effective gun handling skills while demonstrating a proper draw stroke from concealed carry. Additionally, the officer should demonstrate the ability to accurately and consistently hit the target.

EQUIPMENT:

Handgun with off-duty/plain clothes holster, a minimum of one spare magazine, speed loader or stripper clip and a cover shirt or jacket. (36 rounds total)

STANDARD:

To complete this course of fire, officers must demonstrate the ability to accurately and consistently hit the designated target when drawing from concealment, exhibit safe weapon handling, properly scan, assess, and move as designated. Officers must verbally identify themselves as police officers.

DISQUALIFIERS:

Any round that is off target, improper weapon handling, failing to scan assess or move, failing to identify themselves or any other range safety violation.

DISCUSSION TOPICS:

Discuss dangers of armed encounters while off-duty or in plain clothes: proximity of family, not readily identifiable as a police officer, lack of communication equipment, lack of body armor, lack of less lethal force options, etc. Discuss difficulty of drawing from concealment depending on cover clothing.

1. The officer will start at the 15 yard line. Upon the command of threat the officer will move off line while drawing and presenting their weapon. The officer will verbally identify themselves then fire six (6) rounds strong side supported. The officer should scan and assess before holstering.
2. The officer will move to the 10 yard line. Upon the command of threat the officer will move off line while drawing and presenting their weapon. The officer will verbally identify themselves then fire six (6) rounds strong side supported. The officer should scan and assess before holstering.
3. The officer will remain on the 10 yard line. Upon the command of threat the officer will move off line while drawing and presenting their weapon. The officer will verbally identify themselves then fire six (6) rounds strong side **unsupported**. The officer should scan and assess before holstering.
4. The officer will remain on the 10 yard line. Upon the command of threat the officer will move off line while drawing and presenting their weapon. The officer will verbally identify themselves then fire six (6) rounds **weak side** supported. The officer should scan and assess before holstering.
5. The officer will move to the 5 yard line. Upon the command of threat the officer will move off line while drawing and presenting their weapon. The officer will verbally identify themselves then fire a failure to neutralize drill. The officer should scan and assess before holstering (**repeat 4x's total**).
