

#### **Town of Colma Identification Cards**

In order to participate in Town of Colma Recreation Programs at the Colma resident rate, residents must first obtain a Town of Colma Resident Card.

Town of Colma Resident Cards are free to residents and can be obtained at the Colma Community Center.

Residents must show multiple proofs of residency when applying for a Town of Colma Resident Card (i.e., driver's license, utility bill, phone bill, bank statement, etc.)

#### **Program Participation Minimums**

In order to provide a positive experience for residents, each class, program, or activity has a minimum participation requirement. From time to time, a program may be cancelled due to minimum participation numbers not being met. All participants are urged to enroll early to avoid programs being cancelled.

#### **Reasonable Accommodations**

Upon request, this publication will be made available in appropriate alternative formats to persons with disabilities, as required by the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990. Please allow two business days for your request to be processed.

### Program Registration & Facility Reservations

Registration for all programs listed begins upon receipt of the Recreation Guide, unless otherwise noted. You can register for programs in person or online. Please remember, if you are a Colma resident you must come to the Colma Community Center to set up your online account. All facility reservations must be done in person. Accepted forms of payment are cash, checks, or credit cards.

Participants may cancel recreation programs two weeks prior to the start of the program without penalty. If participants cancel recreation programs within two weeks of the start of the program, refunds will not be returned and participants may be responsible for paying the full cost of the program if prepayments to third parties have been made. Also, it is important that you attend recreation programs that you register for, if you fail to attend recreation programs you may also be responsible for the full cost of the program.

For department cancellation of programs, if eligible, your refund will be processed and a check will be sent to you within three to four weeks.



# RESPONSE TO COVID-19

## **Sanitation**

We've modified our programs to adhere to increased sanitation guidelines. We will be limiting use of shared materials and increasing our daily cleaning and sanitizing. We are increasing regular hand washing and access to hand sanitizer when hand washing is not available. High touch areas are sanitized periodically thoughout the day.

## Social distancing and reduced participants

During drop-off and pick-up, we ask that only a single caregiver arrive with the participant(s). Social distancing of at least 6 feet will be required at all times and will be distanced throughout the program. We have also chosen to limit the number of participants per program.

## Face coverings and health screenings

Staff, participants, and caregivers will be required to wear a face covering at all times while in the facility and participating in Recreation programs. In addition, participants temperature will be checked upon arrival. If the participant is exhibiting COVID-19 symptoms, we ask that they do not attend the program. Anyone exhibiting symptoms will be asked to leave and return 72 hours after symptoms end.

## Cancellations and adaptations

We are in a constantly changing environment and we will be following guidelines closely. We are prepared to modify programs if necessary. There may be a need to cancel or reschedule programs. If that occurs, participants will be contacted.
