



## Town of Colma COVID-19 Self-Certification of Vaccination Status

Per Cal/OSHA COVID-19 Prevention Emergency Temporary Standards (ETS), all businesses and governmental entities in California are required to determine and document the COVID-19 vaccination status of their employees. The information collected is confidential and to be used for safety protocols.

Please note that you are required to provide accurate information about your vaccination status in response to the questions below, or alternatively may decline to provide your vaccination status. If you decline to provide information about your vaccination status, we will be required to assume you are unvaccinated and you will be required to follow the rules and requirements pertaining to unvaccinated employees.

I understand that I am required to provide accurate information in response to the question above. I hereby affirm that I have accurately and truthfully answered the question above. I also understand that if I stated that I am vaccinated, my employer may request documentation of my vaccination status (e.g., a copy of my vaccine card or other similar official document confirming vaccination status). Additionally, I understand that if I answer that I am vaccinated without being so, I am subject to legal actions.

I consent to my employer sharing this information with the local health department when required by law.
