Serramonte Blvd Name Change?

Over the past year and as identified in our 2020-2022 Strategic Plan, the Town has identified "Strengthening Auto Row" as an economic development priority program. In an effort to move this initiative forward, the Town is considering changing the name of Serramonte Blvd. to Serramonte Auto Row.

In our discussions amongst Town staff as well as our discussions during the Auto Row Work Group, we feel this change could bring more awareness to Auto Row, strengthen the Auto Row brand and ultimately set the stage to petition Caltrans to change the southbound 280 freeway exit sign to "Serramonte Auto Row."

However, before we consider this change and make a recommendation to the City Council, I would like to hear your feedback, comments, concerns and even endorsement on this potential name change to Serramonte Blvd.
